

## MINUTES

Regular Council Meeting  
Thursday, December 10, 2020  
Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were present. Council Member Jay Boland was unable to attend.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:32pm.

The invitation was given and the pledge to the flag was led.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve last month's minutes. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve last month's financial report. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Dr. Arona with the Gwinnett County Department of Public Health gave an update on the current status of COVID-19.

Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to amend Section 111-73 of the City of Loganville Sign Ordinance by deleting 111-73(b)(1) in its entirety and inserting new 111-73(b)(1) to read Maximum height shall be 20 feet and to delete and replace the Maximum Sign Face table in 111-73(b). Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Due to concerns that have been raised by some citizens and at the request of some members of the council, City Manager Danny Roberts explained that the City Council is not authorized to approve or deny zoning requests for property based on the owner's intention to rent or sell the homes located or built on their property.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the 2020 Harris Computer Systems support contract for \$61,054.94. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the KnowBe4 Security Awareness Training Subscription for \$5,250.96. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the purchase of a 2020 Dodge Durango for Events not to exceed \$32,000.00. Council Member Bill DuVall seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve band concerts with One the Boarder, Swinging Medallions and A1A for the 2021 Grooving on the Green. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the purchase of structural firefighting gear from Bennett Fire Products, Inc. for \$10,490.00. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.




