

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Thursday, January 14, 2021 6:30pm Via Zoom

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting via Zoom on Thursday, January 14, 2021 at 6:30pm. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Mayor Rey Martinez gave the invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to approve the agenda. Council Member Bill Duvall seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve last month's minutes. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve last month's financial report. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the resolution appointing Douglas Kidd as Municipal Court Judge pursuant to a one-year term pursuant to the resolution. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

At this time, Mayor Rey Martinez swore Douglas Kidd in as Municipal Court Judge. (Oath attached to minutes.)

Mayor Rey Martinez opened the floor for nominations for Vice Mayor.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger nominated Linda Dodd for Vice Mayor.

With no additional nominations, Mayor Rey Martinez asked for a motion to close nominations. Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to close nominations. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-2 with Council Members Jay Boland and Lisa Newberry voting in opposition.

Council Members voted 4-2 in favor of Council Member Linda Dodd serving as Vice Mayor for 2021 with Council Members Jay Boland and Lisa Newberry voting in opposition.

Mayor Rey Martinez also presented committee assignments for the year.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to amend the budget to include funding received through the Gwinnett CARES Act for \$308,430.42. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion approve band contracts for the 2021 Concert Series with Rumours – A Fleet Wood Mac Tribute and Roadhouse Atlanta. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the purchase of two submersible pumps for the Briars lift station for \$10,700.00. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to appoint Larry Steele as solicitor. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.




City Manager Danny Roberts also announced that the City has once again been designated a Certified City of Ethics by the Georgia Municipal Association.
