Must work well under pressure and learn assigned territory.

**Qualifications:** completion of High School Diploma or GED; 18 years of age. Possess valid driver's license; satisfactory Motor Vehicle Record (7 year MVR you provide at time of written test).

**Licenses, Certificates and other Requirments:** NPQ firefighter I and II; EMT I or better. The successful applicant must have the ability to obtain any required certifications within 24 months if they do not possess at the time of hiring.

**Must complete:** Satisfactory criminal history (no felony convictions within last 10 years). Applicant must be able to successfully pass a pre-employment written test, physical agility test, and drug screen test.
