Planning & Development Case #V21-003 was presented to the Council. Apex Land Company has requested a reduction in the rear setback from 25' to 20' for 6 units (3.56 acres) located on Sharon Church Road. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to approve Case #V21-003 as presented. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Planning & Development Director Tim Prater presented the updated zoning map to the Council. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to approve the updated zoning map. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the purchase of (2) 2021 Ford F150 for \$45,090.00 (\$5,691.00 to be paid from insurance proceeds from insurance company). Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger reported that out of 15,000 potential citizens 944 responded to the CAG survey and there were 365 comments.




Council Member Bill DuVall presented the Claude Brewer Water Transmission Line Contract with Walton County total contract price \$1,544,284.75. Walton County will reimburse \$450,878.00 toward the project and the remaining \$1,093,406.75 to be paid by the City with 2019 bond proceeds. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd explained to the Council that the Byrd family had approached the City regarding the donation of the pond located on Highway 81 across from Beulah-Land Estates. Council Member Linda Dodd made a recommendation that the City decline the donation at this time due to the amount of repairs that would be necessary to make this property useful. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
