CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Minutes Thursday, May 13, 2021 6:30pm Council Chambers

The Mayor and Council for the City of Loganville met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, May 13, 2021 at 6:30 pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present. Council Members Jay Boland and Danny Ford were unable to attend.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:32pm.

Bill Herrin with C3 Church gave the invocation, American Legion Post 233 Honor Guard presented the Colors and led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to amend the agenda to include the IGA with GDOT under the City Manager. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the agenda. Council Member Bill DuVall seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Mayor Rey Martinez made presentations to Chief Ray Elliot, Mr. Botkin, Lt. Helton, MSG Mark Allen, Foster Care Month Proclamation, LHS Ladies Basketball Team and Mayor for the Day Ava and Ella.

Case #R21-001 was presented to the Council. Storage Cap Loganville, LP c/o Anderson, Tate & Carr, P.C. has requested to rezone 4.53 acres located at Hwy 78 / Hwy 20 from CH to LI for the purpose of constructing a climate control storage facility. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to approve the rezone with the condition that there be no outside storage or outside vehicle parking permitted. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Case #R21-004 was presented to the Council. 412 Conyers Road, LLC has requested to rezone .85 acres located at 412 Conyers Road from R16 to CH for use as office space. Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to approve the rezone as requested. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Lisa Newberry made a motion to appoint Lisa Luttrell to the Planning Commission to fill the vacant seat. Council Member Bill DuVall seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.


Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the 2022 CDBG Grant Resolution (\$500,000.00 Lee Byrd sewer outfall lines). Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve the GDOT Crash Screening \$12,255.00 and ICE Analysis \$19,750.00 necessary to determine the feasibility of the installation of a red light on HWY 78/Publix. Publix Shopping Center to pay up to \$15,000.00 towards cost. Council Member Anne Huntsinger seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.


