### CITY OF LOGANVILLE Regular Council Meeting Thursday, October 14, 2021 6:30pm Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, October 14, 2021 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Rey Martinez and Council Members Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Bill DuVall, Danny Ford, Anne Huntsinger and Lisa Newberry were all present.

Mayor Rey Martinez called the meeting to order at 6:32pm.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Bill DuVall made a motion to approve Last Month's Minutes. Council Member Danny Ford seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Anne Huntsinger made a motion to approve Last Month's Financial Report. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda as follows:

- North Greenville Fitness – Fire Department Physicals - \$8,925.00
- Code Red Annual Invoice - \$8,162.00
- 2022 LMIG Funds - \$178,818.16 (includes 30% match)
- Purchase of Steel Building for equipment storage - \$12,546.00
- ARPA State Grant Approval – City Contribution max \$360,000.00
- Destination Park Improvement Bids – to reject current bids and rebid at later date

Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Rey Martinez presented Poppy Day Proclamation, Hispanic Heritage Day Proclamation and Mayor for the Day AnnaBell Cote.

Council Member Danny Ford made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign the terms and conditions for the GA Public Safety Officials and First Responders Supplement Grant. Council Member Lisa Newberry seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.


It was announced that there would be a ribbon cutting at the treatment plant recognizing the recent upgrades and that Autumn Fest is this Saturday.
