

# Clinical Pathology Case

## What is it?

- Requirement during PGY2 IM Residency
- Focus on presentation of patient case with interesting clinical pathology
- Interdisciplinary presentation in conjunction with pathology resident

## What do I need to do to complete this requirement?

<b>Step 1 – Identify a patient case with interesting pathology (PGY1 and beginning PGY2)</b>	
This may be a case you saw in the office, the hospital, or on a sub-specialty rotation. If you need help identifying a case, talk with your faculty advisor or other attending mentors. Once you have identified a case, call the pathology office (330-375-3666) to talk with one of the pathology residents about the case and whether there are pathology slides/specimens available. You should have a faculty mentor who was involved in the case reviewing the creation/final draft of the presentation for future abstract submission.	
<b>Describe Clinical Focus:</b>	
<b>Step 2 – Create case presentation (February-March)</b>	
Work with your pathology colleague and faculty mentor as co-authors over a period of <i>months</i> to create your case presentation. The pathology should be a substantial component of the case that aided in the diagnosis. Talking points should be presented by the pathology resident as well as you and should help educate other learners on the pathological diagnosis of the disease presented.

<b>Step 3 – Complete Grand Rounds Presentation (April-May)</b>

<b>Step 4 (opt) – Write and Submit an Abstract (March-April)</b>	
Work with your team to refine an abstract for submission at a local, regional, or national conference (general dates below). You may submit your abstract to the appropriate sub-specialty conferences as well.

<b>Step 5 (opt) – Prepare and Complete Conference Presentation using Slides or Poster</b>	
After acceptance, you will work to complete a slide presentation/manuscript or poster for presentation at the accepting conference. Attend the conference and present your work.
