## What is it?

- Requirement during the PGY1 IM Residency
- Focused presentation and review of a recent (<12 months) article of your choosing that highlights a change of care, diagnosis, or treatment

## What do I need to do to complete this requirement?

<b>Step 1 – Identify an article</b>
Pick an article that interests you. Recent and pertinent articles from New England Journal of Medicine, Annals of Internal Medicine, The Lancet, American Journal of Medicine, Journal of American Medical Association, or another article <i>as approved by the Chief Resident</i> .

<b>Step 2 – Review article</b>
Ensure that you have full access to the article you are reviewing. If not, contact the librarians to acquire it. Review “ <i>Improving Journal Club Presentations, or, I can present that paper in under 10 minutes</i> ” posted on the imsumma.org web-site. Use this as your guide for working through the article and its presentation to your colleagues. You can use a powerpoint to help guide you, but you do not have to.
