DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stands out to you about the story of King Jehoshaphat and his prayer in 2 Chronicles 20? What examples can we take from his life and apply to our current circumstances?
2. In 2 Chronicles 20:3 it says that Jehoshaphat “resolved to seek the Lord” in the face of a real threat. To “seek” is to talk to God and wait patiently for Him to respond. What can distract you from talking to and waiting patiently on God during times of uncertainty? What are some practical ways we can spend more time praying and less time worrying this week?
3. What are some other stories from the Bible that have come to mind during this season to encourage and instruct you?
4. Spend time praying (Praise, Remember, Appraise, Yield) as a family.
