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- “New” – Something that was previously unknown (*The Dictionary of Biblical Language* by James Swanson)
- “Creation” – Exclusively God’s Work (*The Dictionary of Biblical Language* by James Swanson)
- Three Signs that Something has Changed Inside of You
 1. You see Jesus differently (v. 16).
 - Jesus is not the problem, He’s the solution.
 2. You see others differently (v. 16).
 - Others are not enemies, they’re image bearers.
 3. You see yourself differently (vv. 14-15)
 - I’m no longer compelled by greed or guilt, but by the love of Christ.
- Key: We must remember that “new” is not the same as “mature.”
