- We are more susceptible to sin in seasons of isolation.
 - Proverbs 18:1
 - Psalm 51 provides a picture of what to do when God sends a Nathan.
 - Nathan = conviction from confrontation.
 - We can be confronted by
 - The Holy Spirit
 - The Word
 - Fellow believers

- Repentance is different than confession and more than saying sorry.
 - David (a man's after God's own heart) shows us what true repentance requires.
 - We must **SEE** it.
 - We must **SAY** it.
 - We must **SUBMIT** to it.
