## NOTE THREE THINGS

- Titus – A pagan name ... Rome had a Titus.
  - How would you know the difference between Titus the Roman emperor and Titus the Christian pastor?
  - Be about good works. The trail it leaves behind identifies what it is you stood for.
- “This saying is trustworthy, and I want you to insist on these things.”
- “Be careful to devote ... To good works.”

## WHAT WOULD SCRIPTURE HAVE US DO?

- Good works require a change of heart.
  - No longer looking behind (or looking around) but focused on Jesus.
  - We need to see the calling in the midst of our crisis.

- Good works display our hope.
  - Our effort matters to others.
  - Our efforts should display light.
- We need to be good news in order to share good news.
