Unity in Ephesians: A supernatural work, made possible through the blood of Jesus Christ (2:13), that brings a diverse group of individuals together to function as one body, supporting and promoting growth in each other through love (4:16).

- Unity starts with you.
 - Unity doesn't start on its own.
 - Unity does not mean uniformity. Unity implies diversity.

- The problem with unity is you.
 - Selfishness, lack of self-control, retaliation, impatience prevent unity.
 - If you can't find unity, check your heart.

- Unity will require something from you.
 - Unity takes work.
 - Satan loves to destroy unity because unity glorifies God.
 - It reflects His nature.
 - It is a testimony to the power of the Gospel.
 - We cannot let these enemies divide us.
