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#### QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS

- Questions and concerns are a natural part of Christian growth.
- God often uses questions and concerns to bring clarity.
  - Key: What do I need to do to be (or stay) saved? (v. 2)
- God can use questions and concerns to build community.
- Questions and concerns can lead the best of us to cut ties.

- Four Questions When Personalities Clash

1. What is the nature of the difficulty?
2. Is there an important biblical principle at stake?
3. What biblical qualities is the Lord trying to develop in me through this clash?
4. Would the cause of Christ be furthered or hindered by continuing to work together?

- What role did the church, the elders and the Holy Spirit play in the debate and resolution of this problem? How could this relate to today?
