

What To Expect As We Reopen

Answers to the most frequently asked questions we've received about the return of live, in-person services at Salem Heights Church.

- **Will we have to register each week?**
Yes, for now. We are requiring weekly registration at first to ensure that we are ready to receive everyone who wants to come. This will only be required for a season and will then be discontinued once we've worked out the kinks.
- **What is available for children?**
*Our nursery will be open for children up to 3 years old. Parents can register their child by visiting the Salem Heights Church website and clicking on the nursery registration link on the homepage. **This is a separate registration process from Sunday services.** Space in our nursery's will be limited when we first open but will increase in the weeks to come. Older children are welcomed to join their parents in the service.*
- **Is there a place for me if I want to have a little more space than in the auditorium and chapel?**
Yes. Room 200 will be set up with tables and will provide a little more distance between households. The service will be viewed via live stream of worship and the message.
- **Will I have to wear a mask?**
Yes. Masks are still required at this time. Children under the age of 5 are not required to wear a mask at church.
- **Will there still be an online option for me if I can't attend the live service?**
Yes. A live stream of our 9am service will be available on YouTube, and then on demand following the service.
- **What is the process of sanitization before and between services?**
Our facilities team will thoroughly sanitize rooms, bathrooms and surfaces throughout the church. This will be done before and after each service. Hand sanitizer will also be available throughout the church.
