### **THE MOVEMENT OF A MOVEMENT**

- In the book of Acts, we see a movement from Jerusalem to the uttermost parts of the earth.
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
- In the book of Acts, we see a movement of the Spirit of God from a place to a person.
  - A Spirit-led Christian gets 3 F's:
    1. You know you are family.
    2. You are known by your fruit.
    3. You let others know about your faith.

- In the book of Acts, we see a movement from Spirit-led apostles (attested to with miracles) to Spirit-led disciples (attested by martyrdom).
- In the book of Acts, we see movement from anticipating the revelation of the Messiah to anticipating the revelation of the Kingdom.

## **APPLICATION**

- Believers can disagree in their conclusions, yet be guided by the Spirit (vv. 5, 12, 13).

Key Question: Has your disagreement led to fellowship or a faction?

- God will find a way to get His will done His way (v. 14).
- Spirit-led faith will compel you to participate equally in motivation different in ministration.
