### **How To Set Up Proxy Access**

#### Children 0 - 11

Visit the clinic or call 920-783-6633 to request proxy access for children under 11. Lakeshore Community Health Care will verify your relationship and grant proxy access.

If you don't have a Lakeshore Health Connect (MyChart) account, sign up at lakeshorechc.org/health-connect. Please use the directions link if you need help signing up.

Children 12 - 17 Limited Access. Patients in this age group can authorize Full Access.

Parents can follow the same directions above.

Foster parents or guardians need to submit custodial orders to LCHC before requesting Proxy Access to MyChart. Lakeshore Community Health Care will not revoke proxy access until notified of a change in the placement/custodial order.

Children 12 - 17 can follow the directions on the right to give parents or guardians full access to their MyChart account.


#### **Adult-to-Adult Proxy Access**


