

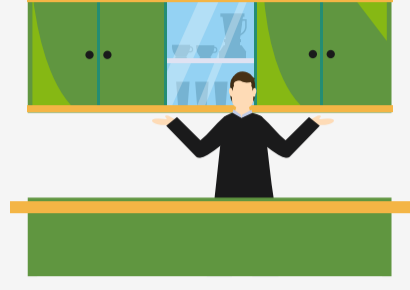
Migrating Nobia to M365

How we helped more than 5000 people work from home efficiently.



Who did we help?

Nobia is Europe's leading developer, manufacturer and retailer of kitchen solutions, with approximately 6 300 employees. Every week, the group manufactures more than 140 000 cabinets and services more than 60 000 consumers in their retail stores.



What was the challenge?

As a result of COVID-19, Nobia needed to help its employees work more efficiently from home. The goals were to:

- Move content from the existing on-premise Intranet to the cloud to make it available from anywhere.
- Configure permissions to give people access only to information intended for them.
- Fast-track adoption of collaboration tools in the form of Teams and SharePoint Team Sites.



The solution



The BSOLVE team worked with Nobia to achieve the following:

- Configured managed user identities, groups and access control with Azure Active Directory.
- Moved the existing Intranet structure and content to SharePoint Online, available from anywhere on any device.
- Planned and implemented the structure and processes needed to create – to date – more than 500 active teams using Microsoft Teams and SharePoint Team Sites.
- Supported the adoption of Teams and Team Sites by training and assisting hundreds of users with the initial setup, structuring and productive use of the collaboration functionality.

In addition, BSOLVE is continuing to promote and support adoption of the rest of the productivity tools in the Microsoft 365 suite, including OneDrive, Planner, Lists and Stream.

The successes

1 Anywhere access



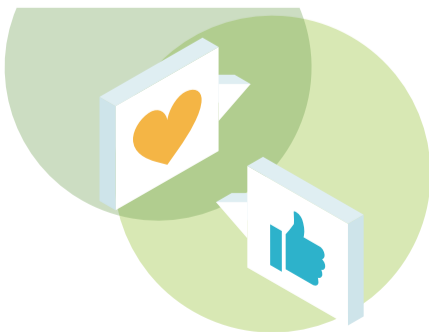
- Users can now access all Intranet-related content regardless of their location or network connection
- Individuals now securely store and share files with authorised parties using OneDrive.

2 Borderless collaboration

- Collaborative conversations and file sharing between both internal and external stakeholders is now part of the remote work style.
- Real-time co-authoring of documents has become a regular occurrence, enabled by the cloud-connected 365 versions of the Microsoft Office apps.



3 User adoption of the new way of working



- Monthly Teams conferencing calls increased from 3 500 to more than 28 000.
- Monthly Teams meetings increased from 8 000 to just under 30 000.
- 2.7 million chat messages were sent
- 55 000 mentions were made in chats and channels
- 175 000 emoji reactions were sent
