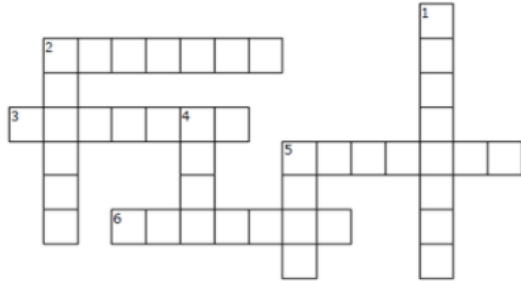

- 5. To keep someone from being killed or injured; to rescue

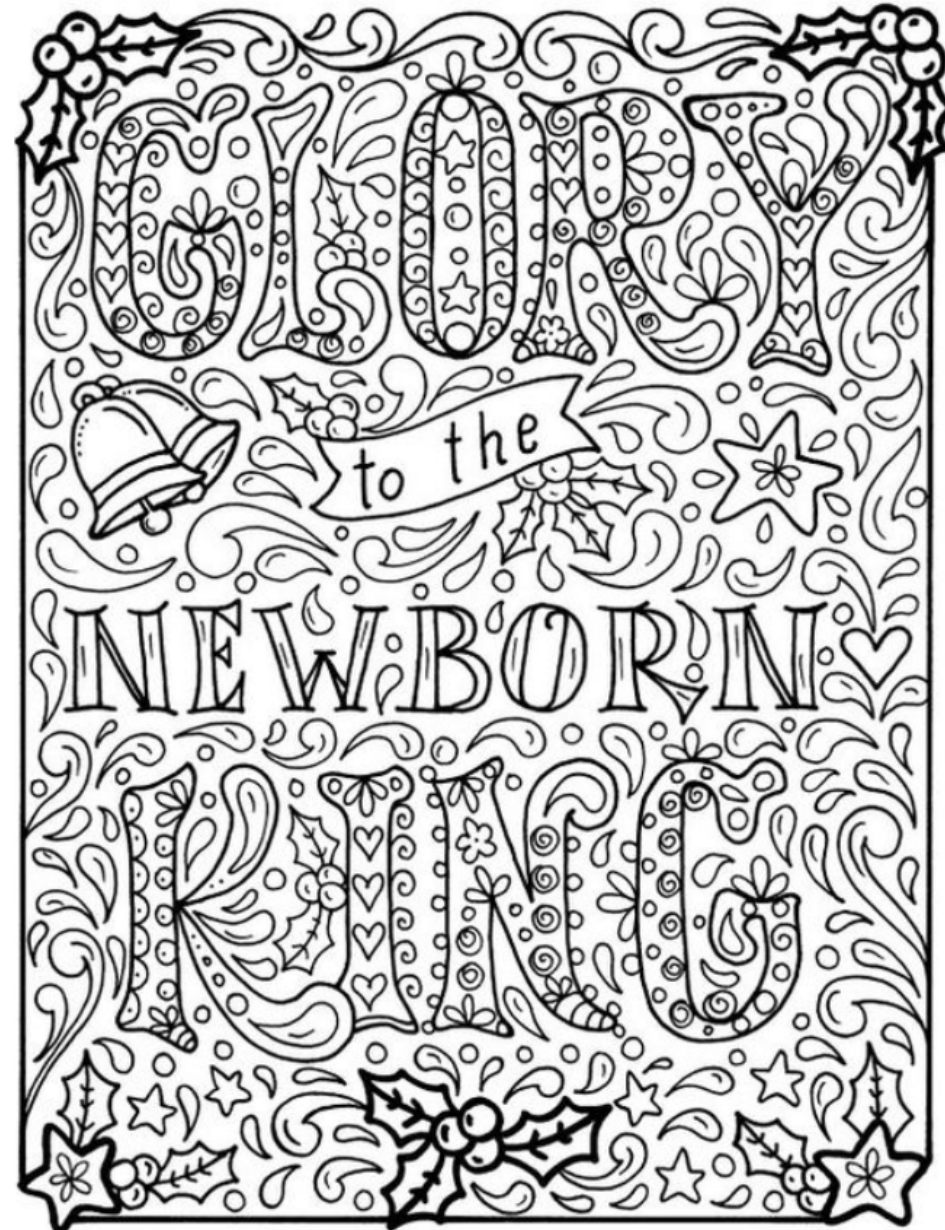
