- Participate in the creation, submittal, and approval process for MOPs and CMs required for both Construction and Service efforts.
- Track materials and subsequent coordination of delivery and transfer to subcontractors.
- Participate in the periodic maintenance and service of existing controls systems.
- Assist in system commissioning, including H2C, cutover, and IST processes.

BAS Technicians may support multiple projects. Travel to various sites is required.

- Tridium AX Certification required
- Experience with BACnet and Modbus protocols required

- Experience with AutoCAD and Bluebeam Revu preferred
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail
- Experience integrating third party devices and software
