Environmental Policy Statement

Our Commitment

- ▶ Where possible will ensure that suitable storage, transportation and disposal of products and waste using competent licensed contractors.
- ▶ Endeavour to keep waste to a minimum during our working activities.
- ▶ Seek to continually improve our environmental performance by reducing the amount of energy consumption wherever possible.
In order to minimise fuel consumption, company vehicles are carefully selected and will be regularly serviced. Business journeys will normally be planned to take the shortest route.
- ▶ Monitor environmental issues and endeavour to improve our performance in line with current best practice.
- ▶ Provide sufficient information and training to enable employees to improve our Environmental Management Standard.
- ▶ Encourage suppliers and sub contractors to develop and apply the best possible Environmental practice.
