BACKGROUND

Awarded to Alephs and B'nai B'rith Girls who truly embody the Menorah Pledge and Seven Cardinal Principles, The Menorah Pledge & Cardinal Principles Award honors those teens that have dedicated their time and energy to promoting the values of our Order.

The award also recognizes Alephs and B'nai B'rith Girls who have embraced the ideals of the Menorah Pledge and Cardinal Principles and regularly live by them in all aspects of their life.

CRITERIA

Recipients of this award are nominated by their fellow Alephs and B'nai B'rith Girls, making this an especially noteworthy award.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Step 1: Nomination Summary

You will be asked to answer each of the following questions:

1. Why do you feel that your nominee embodies the Menorah Pledge (for BBG) or the Seven Cardinal Principles (for AZA)?
2. Describe a specific example in which your nominee exemplified the behavior that the Menorah Pledge and the Seven Cardinal Principles embody. How did others react to your nominee's effort?
3. How has this Aleph or B'nai B'rith Girl portrayed the ideals of the Menorah Pledge (BBG) and Seven Cardinal Principles (AZA) outside of AZA and BBG?

Step 2: Staff Recommendation

In order for your nominee to receive the Menorah Pledge & Cardinal Principles Award, your nominee must receive a brief professional staff or chapter advisor recommendation.

Please ask one staff member to write a recommendation of no more than 250 words explaining why your nominee is deserving of this award and how your nominee has been a role model to other Alephs and B'nai B'rith Girls. You must have this completed when you apply for the award, for it must be uploaded and submitted as part of the online application process.
