

Information and Tuition

Our Summer PREP is Monday, June 18, 2018 to Friday June 29, 2018, **from 8 AM to noon. To complete this program, your child must be in attendance every day. Your child may not miss for doctor, orthodontist, dentist appointments, etc. (See Below)**

Classes are held in the Annunciation School building. We will have a 20-minute recess/snack break each day. Soft pretzels will be available. A separate order form for snacks will be sent via email after registration is completed. For your child to receive a snack, you must complete the snack order form and pay in full. You also have the option to send your own snack from home.

Students will line up by grade in the school yard each morning. Teachers will take their line to their classroom. You will be notified by email as to what supplies your child will need.

Class size is limited. Please return your registration promptly. You can drop your registration off at the Wexford entrance of the rectory (next to the garage). Please put all registrations in the box marked Summer PREP registrations. There is no need to ring the bell. All checks should be made payable to Annunciation BVM.

SACRAMENT YEARS:

Since these students are participating in PREP well before the actual sacrament, we will have a refresher class as the sacrament date approaches. If your child is receiving their 1st Penance, 1st Eucharist, or Confirmation, he or she must attend this refresher class in order to receive the sacrament. First Penance & First Communion is received in 2nd grade and Confirmation is in 7th grade.

Please return your registration by **April 20**. Half payment is due with registration on or before April 20th and full payment is due May 20th. After April 20, we will open registration to our new families.
