Charlie comes to us from the Cherokee Nation where he has spent the last 6 years as a construction Project Manager, primarily managing projects for the BIA in schools on the Navajo reservation in New Mexico and Arizona. Previously he was the Facility Manager for the Bristow Public Schools. During his time at Bristow he was heavily involved in the OSPMA, serving 2 terms on the Board of Directors including a term as President of the organization.

Charlie has been involved in the construction industry all of his adult life and has strong ties to public education in the state. His wife of 45 years, Marie, retired as middle school secretary from Bristow Public Schools after 30+ years of service. Both of his daughters are public school teachers in the state and his father in law was the County Superintendent for Creek County schools for many years.

Charlie has stated his desire is to expand the influence of the OSPMA by gathering input from Superintendents and Facility Managers throughout the state. His goals are to update the training and breakout sessions provided at our yearly conference, to provide more timely information and updates to member schools through the OSPMA website, and to provide regular news letters to our member schools.
