Kari taught in the K-12 public school system with students on the autism spectrum for 30+ years and was founding member of MN Autism Project. She developed an Autism Spectrum Disorders Certificate program for educators at Hamline University in St. Paul, MN and is on the Advisory Board for the Autism Society of Trinidad and Tobago and the Autism Society of MN. Kari is co-author of The Incredible 5-Point Scale, and the author of When My Worries Get Too Big (winner of the 2013 Mom’s Choice Award!), A 5 Could Make Me Lose Control!, and A 5 is Against the Law! (2008 ASA literary award winner).
