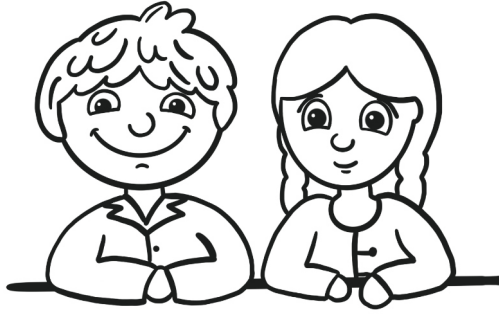

# Character description scavenger hunt

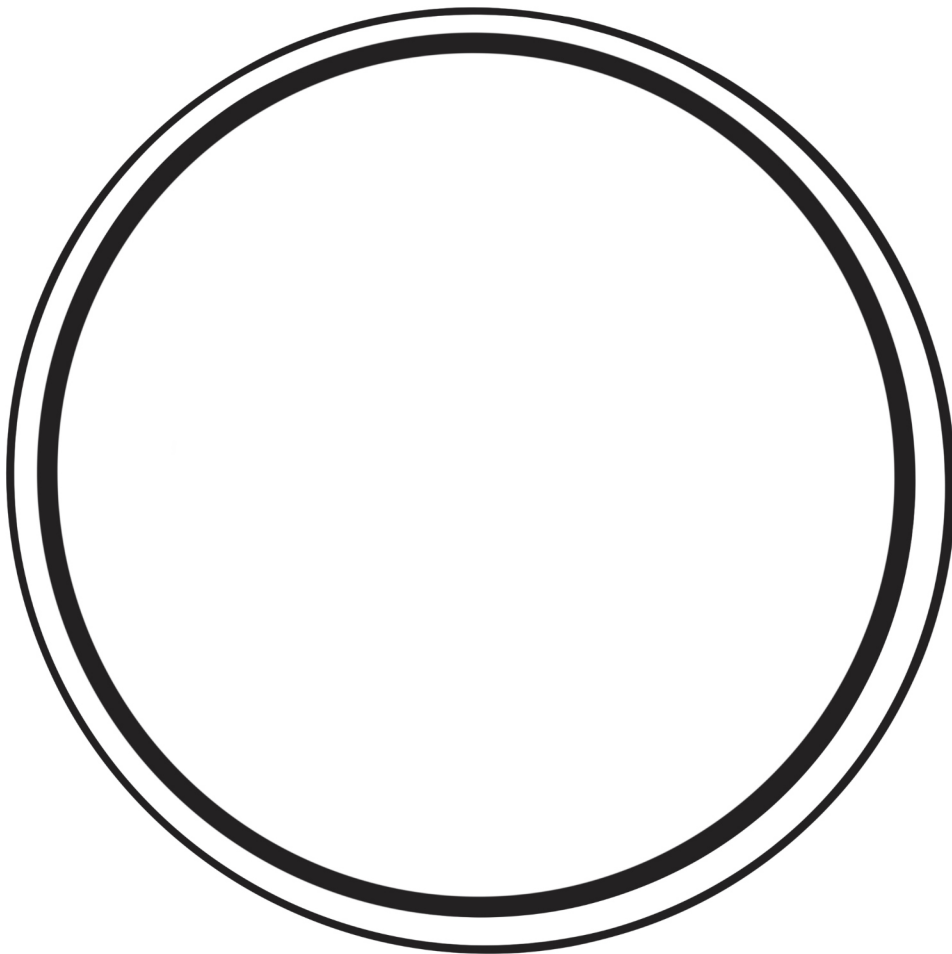

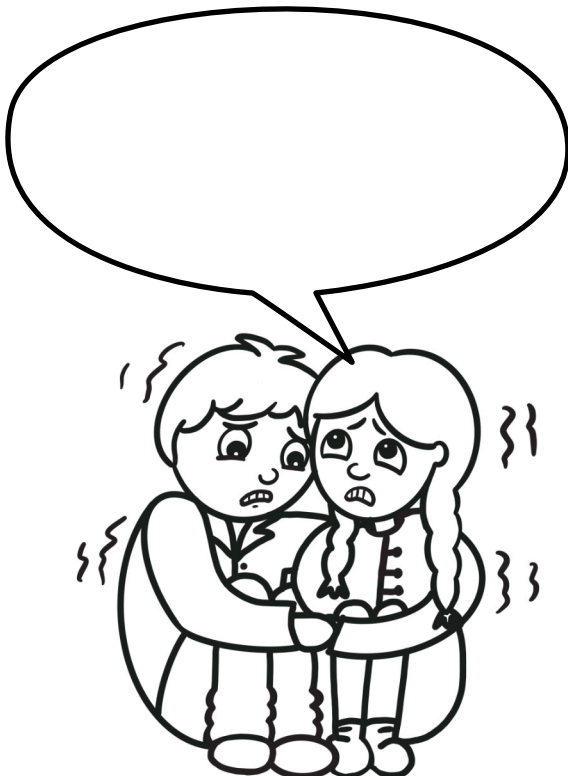
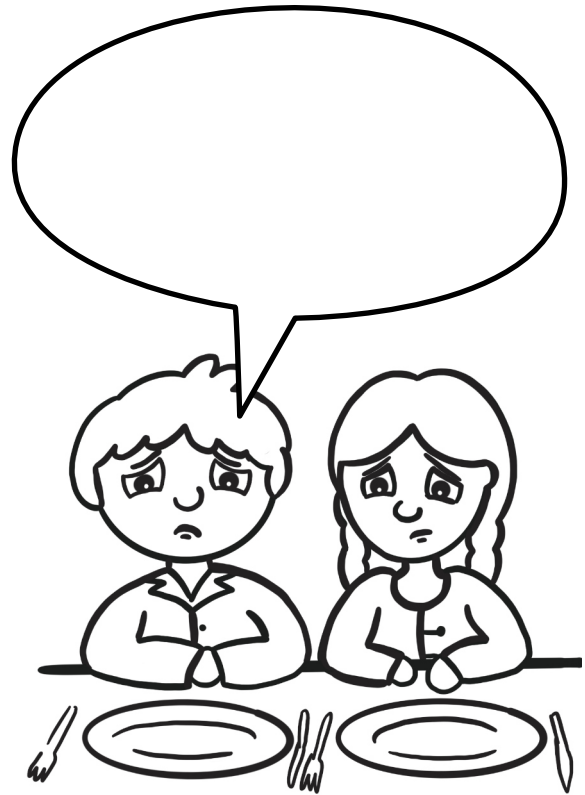
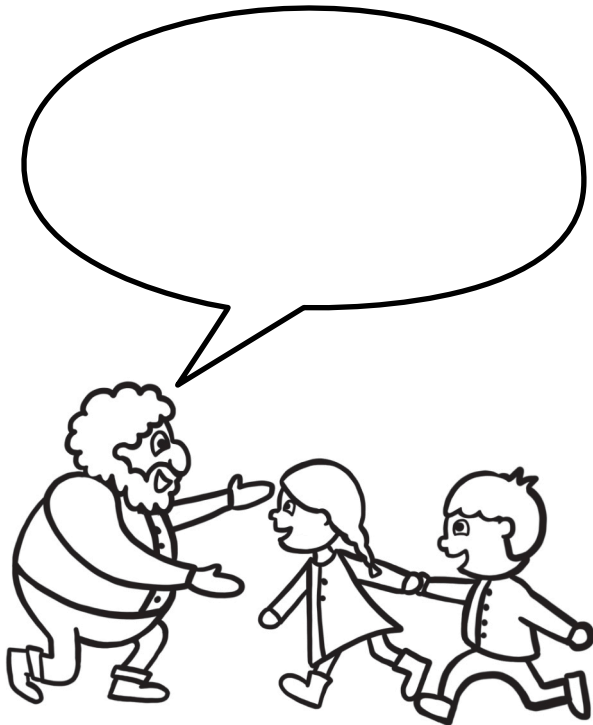
# How do you feel?







**DIRECTIONS (part 2):** Now look at the pictures below. How do the characters feel? Use the phrases you just learned in the chart on the previous page.
