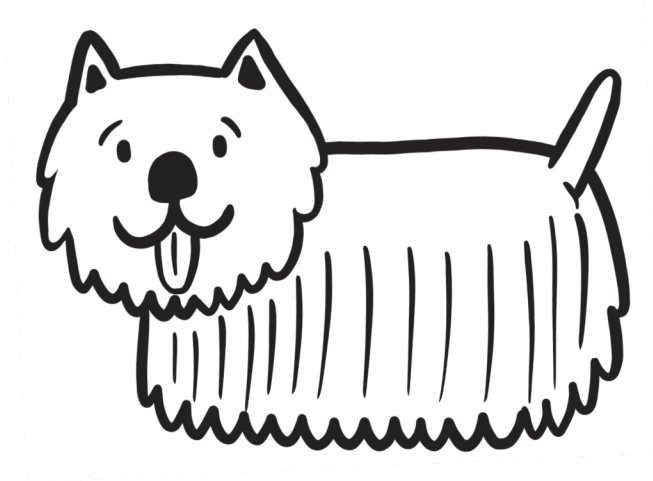
# Comparing the characters
