

COMPREHENSION CHECK

Hungry, Hungry Crocodile

DIRECTIONS: After reading *El enano saltarín* in **Spanish**, see how much of the story students understood by playing *Hungry, Hungry Crocodile*.

1. Cut out each strip below and read each statement with students.
2. On the two blank strips, have students write two more statements about the story — **one truth** and **one lie**. (For younger students, help them write their statements.)
3. On the next page, play *Hungry, Hungry Crocodile*. Read each statement. Have students decide if it is true or a lie.
4. If they think it is true, have them put it in **the king's** pile. If they think it's a lie, feed it to **the crocodile!**

The little man had brown curly hair and red pointy shoes.

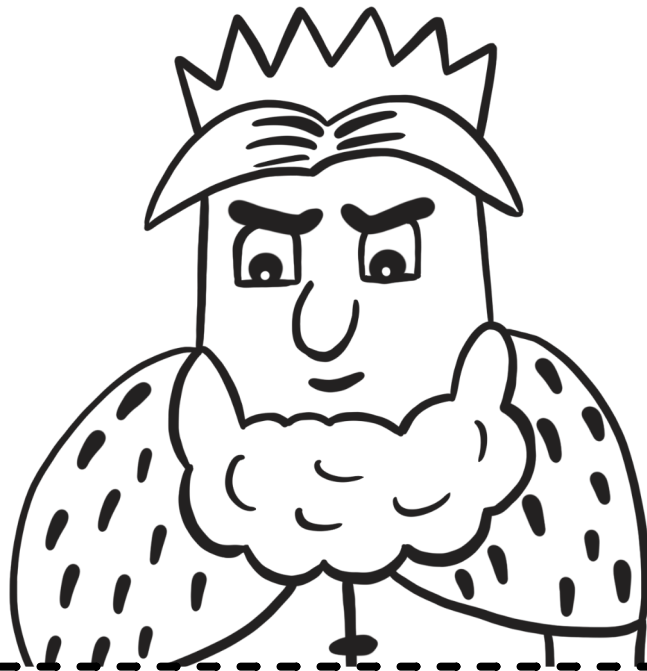
Sofía guessed the little man's name.

The hatmaker always tells the truth.

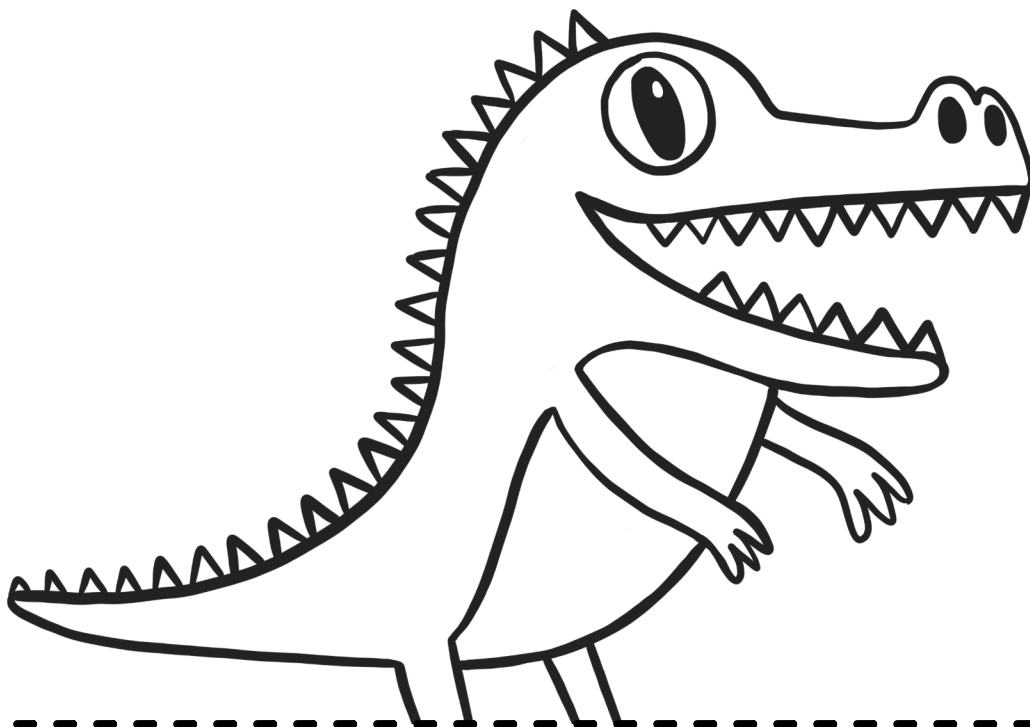
The little man's name was Chris.
