i capelli

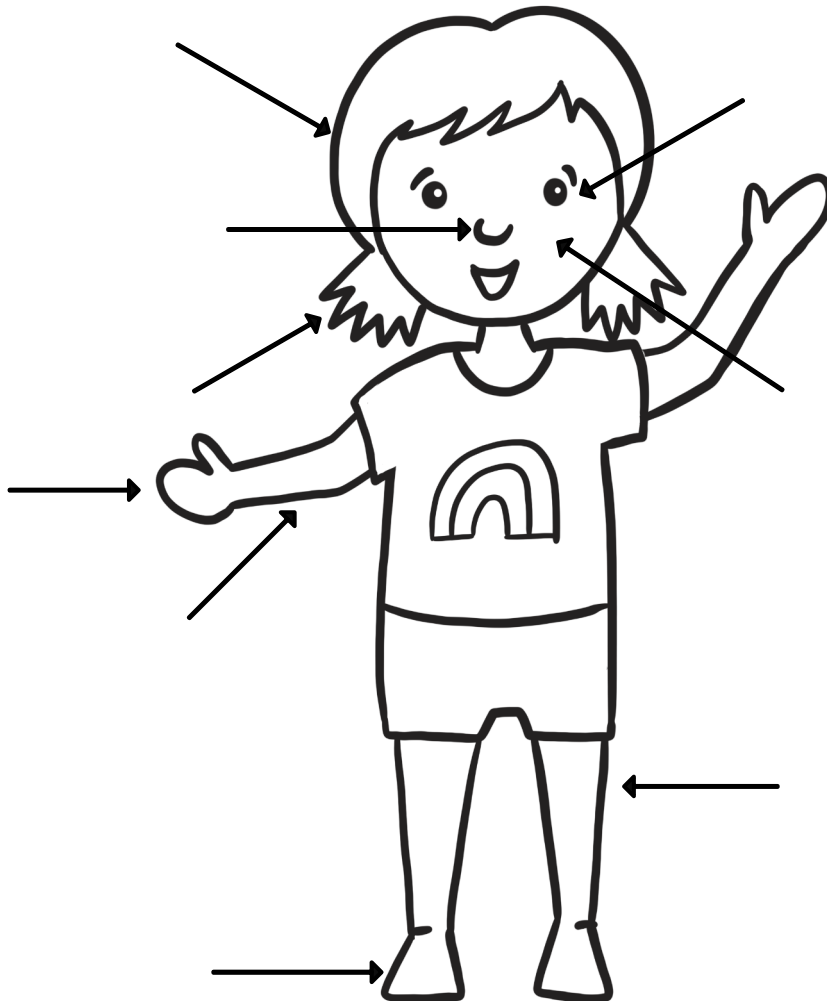
