# Who am I?

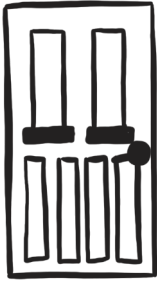
**DIRECTIONS:** In this story you heard many descriptions of people. Let's practice describing people by playing, *Who Am I?*

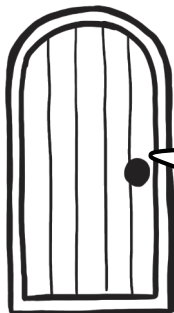
