Write a love letter

DIRECTIONS: This activity will help you practice comparing things in Spanish. You heard a lot of comparisons in **Blancanieves y los siete enanitos**. In English, we have a few ways of comparing things:

1. Sometimes we use the words *more* or *most*: **more beautiful, most beautiful.**
2. Sometimes we add *-er* or *-est* to the end of a word: **big, bigger, biggest.**
3. Or we can say two things are the same with the phrase *as ___ as ___*: **as blue as the ocean.**

How do comparisons sound Spanish? Go back and read **Blancanieves y los siete enanitos** again. This time, stop when you hear these comparisons. Write down the translations in the chart.
