Our Program

CFK's Lishe Bora Mtaani serves children who have been identified by staff and community health volunteers as severely malnourished, and their families.

0-5 **Target Population**
Our program focuses on children under 5.

7 **Villages in Kibera**
This past year, we expanded to 4 new villages in Kibera.

250 **Health Volunteers**
Over 250 volunteers conduct household health visits across Kibera.

▶ Reducing Rates of Malnutrition

Focused on bringing severely malnourished children back to full health, we reached the following through our nutrition program:



Household Health Visits **2,747**



Children screened for malnutrition **5,963**



Vitamin & Deworming supplementation **16,310**

▶ Impacting the Community

Lishe Bora Mtaani also incorporates both early childhood and parent education across the scope of its services. Early childhood educators provide educational instruction and support developing social skills, while providing three nutritious meals per day.



245 children were brought back to full health.



5,449 children under the age of 6 months were immunized.



854 mothers counseled to support exclusive breastfeeding.



16 training sessions reaching **322** parents, caregivers and health providers.

SEPTEMBER 8
World Breastfeeding Week Event

Over 900 community members attended our event held during World Breastfeeding Week, which addressed how men and fathers can better support breastfeeding and be an advocate for the women and children in their lives.

OCTOBER 2017
Malezi Bora Week

Over 250 early childhood development centers were trained and equipped with functional hand washing stations, and **2,375 children** received assessments.

NOVEMBER 12
World Pneumonia Day Event

Close to 300 community members attended our World Pneumonia Day event during which staff distributed hand washing station equipment and supplies for families living in Kibera.
