Wheels at Wanaka is a biennial event, held at Three Parks, Wanaka. The event alternates every odd Easter weekend with Warbirds Over Wanaka International air show and combines normally separate events into one "all-wheels in motion" vintage fair – including steam & traction engines, tractors & farming heritage, cars, motor-bikes, trucks, earthmovers and heavy machinery.

Buzzing with energy, Wheels at Wanaka is huge! With over 50 acres of entertainment, outputting tonnes of horsepower, with tractor dancing and tractor pulling, 4WD, dirt bikes and ATV demos, an earthmoving extravaganza within a full-on parade ground programme. A weekend is barely enough to see everything.

Wheels at Wanaka's inaugural 2019 event attracted 12,000 visitors over 2 days. In 2021 we will be adding an extra Earthmoving only day on Good Friday 2 April and expect a total of 20,000 attendees to attend over 3 days.

Open to all big and small rigs, vintage classic or modern. From a Morris to a Mack, if you have a truck that is old school cool or the latest, biggest, and best, you are welcome to enter!

3. Tractor & Farming Heritage Fair

Open to Vintage to Modern Tractors, Stationary Engines, Steam Engines, Vintage and Farming Machinery. We are celebrating the history of farming and country life through the years and would love to see your machines.

4. Terra Cat Earthmoving Extravaganza

Open to all Construction and Earthmoving machinery, old or new, big or small. If it's a bulldozer, digger, scraper or loader it will be on display so please enter some of your gear!

Wheels at Wanaka is both a working exhibition and a static display. Please tick the box if you are interested in working your machine or participating in our parade.

- Good Friday, 2 April 2021 – 10am – 4pm
- All Enthusiasts and visitors are encouraged to also purchase passes for our extra day in 2021, the NEW Terra Cat Mega Earthmoving ONLY Day.
- These 1-day passes are available for \$10 per adult and \$5 per youth.

Camping Pass – Self Contained Motorhomes and Caravans

- There are a limited number of camp sites available to Enthusiasts and Trade Stall Holders Only. Self-Contained Motorhomes, Trucks or Caravans are welcome to stay onsite at our Campground from Easter Friday to Easter Monday. Camping will only be allowed in our designated camp site.
- \$10 per person, covers the entire Easter weekend. Kids 12 & under are FREE
- **NOTE:** Sites are non-powered with simple ablution facilities and drinking water provided. If you are an eligible entrant, you must purchase your camping pass online before 31 March 2021. If you are not sure if you are eligible, you can check by emailing info@wheelsatwanaka.co.nz

Please ensure you read through the following, so you are aware of Wheels at Wanaka's onsite expectations. You can find a copy of the Wheels at Wanaka Health & Safety Regulations at www.wheelsatwanaka.co.nz. By entering online, you agree with this policy. The following points are a simple guide for Wheels entrants to help us all enjoy a safe event. A separate set of Terms and Conditions will be provided to all Trade and Food Stall Exhibitors. Please note for the safety of all entrants, exhibitors and visitors alike, we are asking that you please adhere to the following rules, that there will be:

- **Please No Dogs or livestock are allowed in vehicles or onsite. Please leave them at home.**
- NO BYO FOOD OR ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED. Food and drinks are available to purchase onsite.
- No Smoking is allowed on site.
- Operators and drivers or any machine or vehicle / exhibit shall not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol inside the venue grounds.
- Only suitably qualified people are to operate or drive vehicles and machinery. Operators and drivers or any machine vehicle, or exhibit being moved, operated, or driven inside the event area shall be 16 years of age or older and competent to do so.
- Powder or foam types of fire extinguisher are required to be present at the display area for every stationary engine exhibitor.
- No passengers on vehicles or machinery unless the vehicle or machine is designed for passengers. No standing on drawbars.
- Walking speed is the maximum speed for any vehicle or machine moving inside the Wheels at Wanaka venue grounds.
- Fuel shall be kept in safety containers. Petrol: a maximum of 10ltr per container and Diesel: a maximum of 20ltr. Please note for larger machines Central Machine Hire will have a refuelling truck available.
- All Wheels at Wanaka event Facilitators and/or area Convenors are Health and Safety officers. Their decisions are final in any decision/dispute.
- **CAMPING:**
 - There is a limited number of camping sites for self-contained motor homes. **Camp sites are reserved strictly for Wheels Entrants ONLY.** If you are eligible entrant, you must book and pay to camp before 31 March 2021 via this form or by [emailing info@wheelsatwanaka.co.nz](mailto:info@wheelsatwanaka.co.nz)
 - Camping must be strictly inside the allocated camp ground. There will be no unauthorised camping within the event site, if you are found camping within the camp site and do not have approval you will be asked to leave the event.
 - **There is no onsite camping available for event visitors or public ticket holders.**
 - A list of approved campers will be registered with Wheels at Wanaka and a contact list provided to QLDC. If you are found camping but not listed, you will be asked to move on by Wheels at Wanaka Security.
