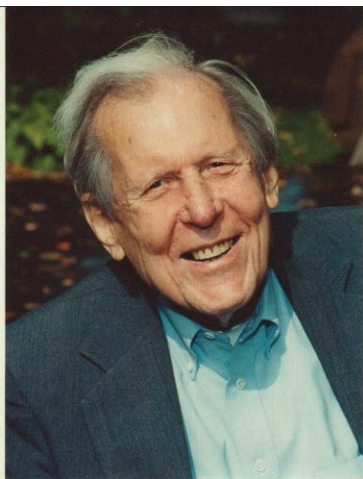
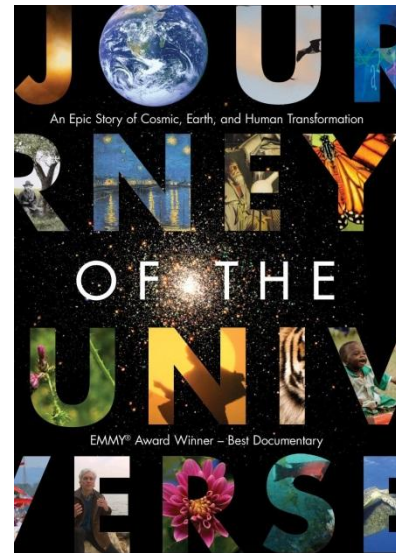


# Living Cosmology: Christian Responses to *Journey of the Universe*
