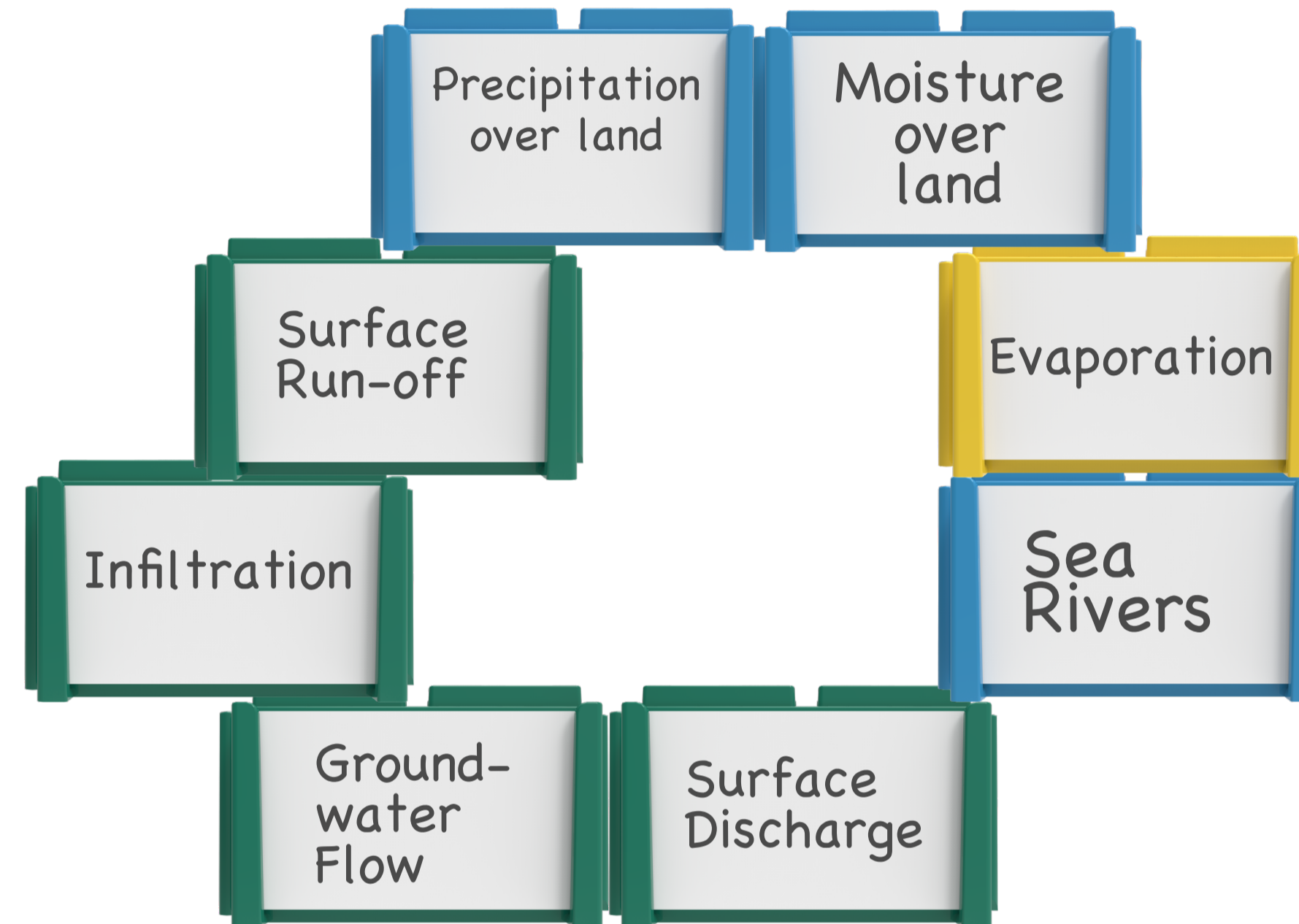


Sequencing Ideas into a Logical Order

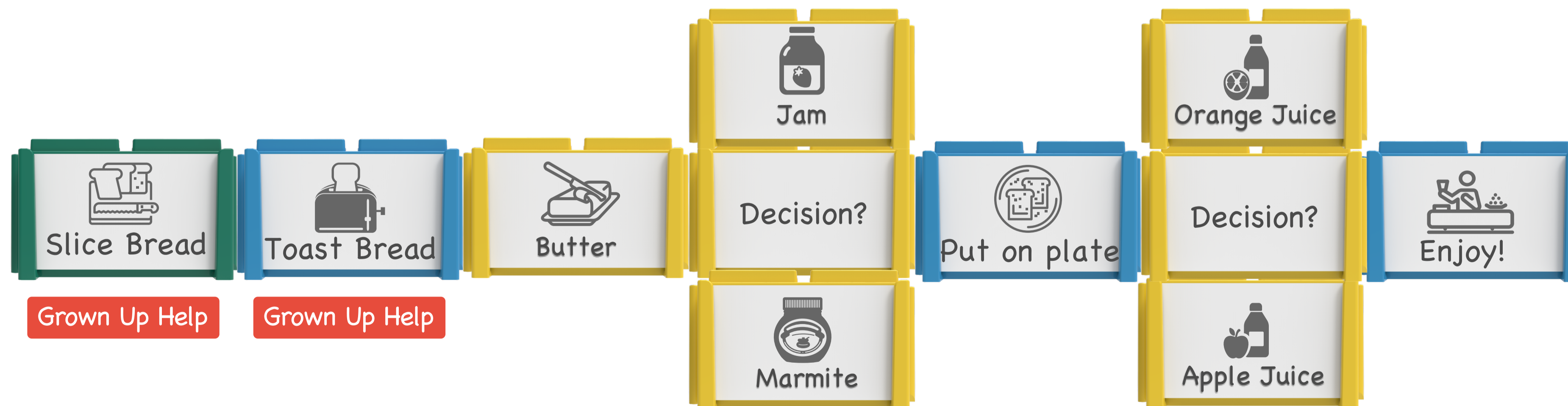
Identifying the sequence of events or actions is an important way of establishing what happened or what will happen. This process has useful applications for writing instructions, unpicking historical events or deconstructing a chapter of a book. The white boards can be used to symbolise the important points with key words or pictures. As learners connect the bricks into a logical order they might also start to explore causal relationships.
