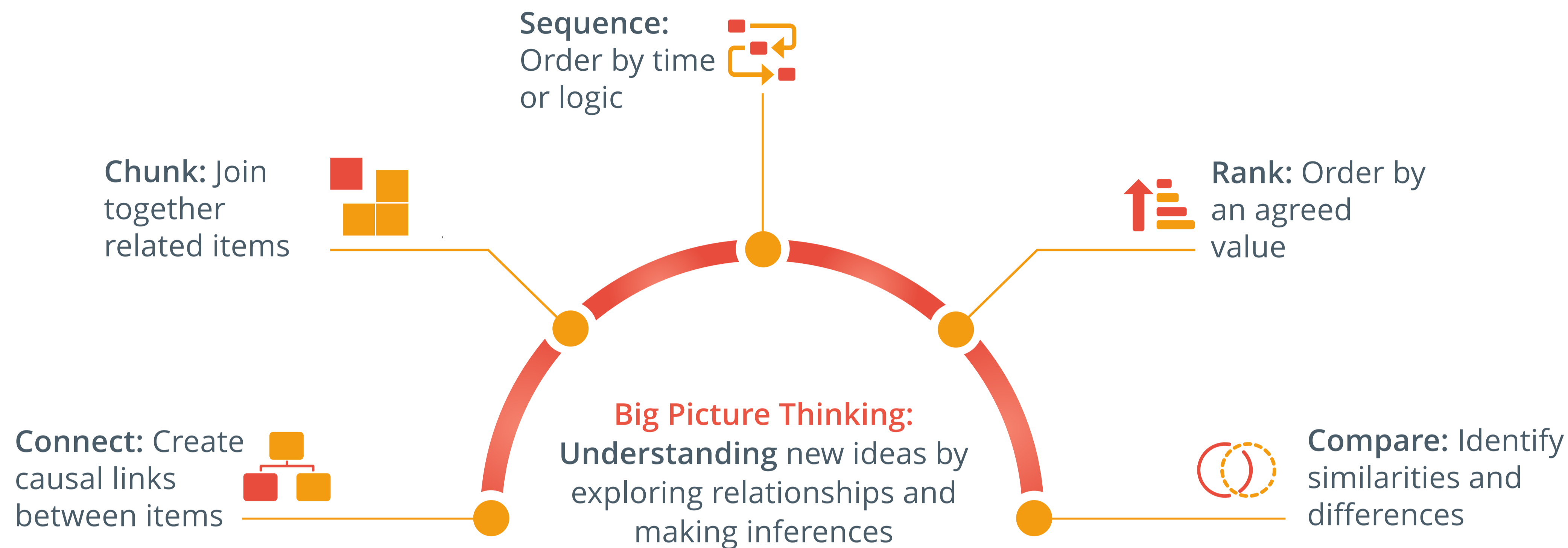


Putting Structural Learning to Work.
