PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Practices transparent, authentic Christian values and principles publicly and privately.
2. Worships Jesus wholeheartedly. It is the passion of his/her life to be a disciple of Jesus Christ.
3. Yearns for excellence in all he/she does, yet sees the value of the person as more important than the perfection of the ministry.
4. Can work with others with sensitivity and humility.
5. Honors and practices confidentiality.
6. Has a servant's heart and teachable spirit. Practices "going the second mile" in accomplishing work and creating and maintaining positive relationships.
7. An active, participating member of Union Chapel or be willing to become a member at the beginning of employment.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Engage in pastoral responsibilities as assigned.
2. Assist in establishing ministry goals and objectives, and individual tactics that support the mission and vision of the Church.
3. Help recruit, train, schedule, equip and supervise volunteers for the ministry.
4. Participate in weekly Creative Arts Team (CAT) meetings and monthly All-Staff Meetings, scheduled departmental meetings, and other required staff events.
5. Engages in a regular and ongoing (meeting at least monthly) accountability relationship with a staff partner or other approved person.
6. Oversee and lead the Oneighty (Youth) Worship ministry.
7. Lead worship for main weekend services, a 1,300 total attendance in two different venues.
8. Arrange musical selections for the worship team as assigned.
9. Evaluate and assist in gathering resources to be used by the worship teams.
10. Prepare Ableton Live sets and ProPresenter songs for all worship services.
11. Assist in leading the weekly rehearsals, planning of worship elements, and in the musical and spiritual development of worship team members.

SECONDARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Other duties, responsibilities, and/or ministries may be negotiated, acquired or assigned dependent upon experience, gifting, and abilities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Experience: Minimum of two (2) years leading contemporary worship.
2. Education: Minimum of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A degree from an accredited Bible college with a major in biblical studies or a related field is preferred. Consideration will be given to candidates having experience and demonstrated proficiency in

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field.

3. Knowledge, skills, and gifts: Must be able to effectively schedule and lead rehearsals, organize and lead service planning sessions as directed, and share in the leading of weekend worship in various venues, as assigned. The candidate should demonstrate excellent vocal skills, as well as proficiency in leading worship while playing a musical instrument. Candidate must be tried and proven in ministry and have a passion to share Jesus. Candidate must demonstrate a Christ-like attitude in words and actions, have the ability to work with a wide variety of people, and exhibit excellent interpersonal relational skills while maintaining and protecting confidentiality. Candidate must possess effective written and verbal skills. Must be a motivated and successful recruiter and manager of volunteers.
