

Kids@UC Reopening FAQ's

What time will the doors open?

Kids@UC will open 15 minutes before service begins.

Will Kids@UC Online still be available?

[Kids@UC Online](#) will be available on the Monday following our weekend services.

How do I prepare for Check-In?

Kids@UC has moved to a completely touch-less check-in system. Prior to arriving on campus, download the Church Center app and select Union Chapel as your home church.

How will Check-Out work with the Church Center App?

Using the Church Center app, you will be asked to present the “check-out” barcode to the Kids@UC Security Guard and to your kids’ leader. This barcode replaces the secure pick up tag.

What additional changes have been made that I need to be aware of?

- We ask that only one parent accompany kid(s) into the Kids@UC secure area. We encourage you to allow your kid(s) to navigate (with the help of Kids@UC staff and leaders) to their own classroom from the Kids@UC security door.
- Please make yourself aware of the traffic patterns ([see map](#)) indicated on the floors and maintain appropriate social distances during check-in, in the hallways, at the classroom, and during check-out.
- All K-3rd graders will be meeting in the Kids@UC Auditorium and infants - 5 year olds will meet in their normal classrooms.

Do the kids need to wear a mask to Kids@UC?

Due to Governor Holcomb's mask mandate, masks are required for kids over the age of 8 and highly recommended for kids ages 2-7. Our staff and leaders will be wearing masks and encourage you to send your kid(s) with one.

Will the kids be singing and worshipping?

Yes, we will be singing together during our worship time.

Will the kids be offered a snack/drink while at Kids@UC?

No, we will not be offering a snack and our water fountains have been turned off for the time being. Feel free to send your kid with a water bottle with their name clearly written on it.

Do the kids need to bring anything with them to Kids@UC?

We recommend sending kid(s) to Kids@UC with their Bible, a water bottle, and a mask. We will not be providing kids with Bibles at this time.

How will Kids@UC handle social distancing?

The Kids@UC staff and leaders will do their best to encourage social distancing recommendations as outlined by the CDC.

What cleaning and sanitizing will be done?

Staff and leaders will be cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces before and after each service. Toys in the classrooms have been divided between services and will only be used by one service and then sent to be cleaned and sanitized. Additional hand-sanitizer stations have been made available throughout the Kids@UC area.

What if my kid is sick or has symptoms?

Anyone who is sick or displays COVID-19 symptoms as defined by the [CDC](#), should stay home and participate in [Kids@UC Online](#) on Monday. We ask that families do their part in self monitoring symptoms.

What if we aren't ready to return to Kids@UC?
