



REOPENING FAQ'S

What time will the doors open?

Kids@UC will open 15 minutes before service begins.

How do I prepare for Check-In and Check-Out?

Download the Church Center app and select Union Chapel as your home church.

Using the Church Center app, scan the "check-in" QR code at a self check station in the Kids Lobby. After service, open the Church Center app and present the "check-out" barcode to the Kids@UC Security Guard and to your kids' leader to be scanned.

Do the kids need to wear a mask to Kids@UC?

Due to Governor Holcomb's mask mandate, masks are required for kids over the age of 8 and highly recommended for kids ages 2-7. Staff and leaders will be wearing masks and encourage kids to do so.

Do the kids need to bring anything with them to Kids@UC?

We recommend sending kid(s) to Kids@UC with their Bible, a water bottle, and a mask.

How will Kids@UC handle social distancing, cleaning, and sanitizing?

The Kids@UC staff and leaders will do their best to encourage social distancing recommendations as outlined by the CDC.

Staff and leaders will be cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces, toys, and supplies before and after each service. Toys in the classrooms have been divided between services and will only be used by one service and then sent to be cleaned and sanitized.

What additional changes have been made that I need to be aware of?

We ask that only one parent accompany kid(s) into the Kids@UC secure area. Infants - 5 year olds should be dropped off first, followed by K- 3rd graders, in order to adhere to the traffic patterns ([see map](#)) indicated on the floors. All kids will meet in their normal classrooms.

What if my kid is sick or has symptoms?
