4. Coordinate services and deliver messages during Sunday nights student services.
5. Coordinate ministry/office logistics (budgets, communications, event planning, etc.).
6. Provide oversight and development to the Youth Ministry Staff and adult volunteers.
7. Preach as part of the preaching team in main services 2 to 3 times annually.
