Overview

WHY PLASTIC? consists of three one-hour investigative documentary films that will be broadcasted at BBC and our 70+ broadcasting partners all over the world. They will also be made available free of charge to schools, universities, libraries, museums and community organisations.

Responsibilities

1. *Funding*: Identifying and applying for funds, both for the films and the campaign. You will do this together with other THE WHY staff and/or other interns, but you will also get to try out writing applications independently
2. *Outreach*: Identify and contact potential partner organisations that would be interested in participating in the WHY PLASTIC? Campaign.
3. *Production Assistance*: You will get insight into the production of the documentaries, and assist in production related administrative tasks.
4. *Research*: You will be doing lighter research tasks for the documentaries, short films and the additional material needed for the website

Knowledge/Skills/Experience

1. Excellent communication skills in English (and Danish would be a bonus), both written and verbal. Comfortable liaising with multiple stakeholders independently.
2. Highly organized with strong administrative capabilities.
3. Experienced user of Excel and GSuite.
4. Excellent attention to detail and a critical mindset, particularly in terms of research.
5. Keeps up-to-date with current affairs and political developments.
6. Good knowledge of documentary film and a strong interest in working in the industry.
7. Previous experience of grant fundraising is highly desirable.
8. Any experience with environmental issues/advocacy/activism is a bonus.
