



Detention and Exclusion Policy

At Fearn Community Sports College, Poor behaviour may be punished by detention, internal exclusion, direction, 9-5, exclusion or a fixed term exclusion.

Detentions

Detentions are expected to be reasonable and in proportion to the nature of the offence. Teachers should take into account individual circumstances such as the child's age, special educational needs, religious requirements and whether or not suitable transport arrangements are available for the child to travel home from school after the detention.

Detentions may be at break, lunchtime and end of the school day. Where a pupil is to be detained for more than 10 minutes beyond the school day then 24 hours written notice will be given.

Failure to complete a detention will result in the length of detention increasing up to 1 hour.

Exclusions

Where a pupils behaviour falls below expected standards they will be referred to the appropriate senior member of staff and when necessary the Headteacher. Sanctions include 9-5, isolation, direction or a fixed term exclusion as proportionate to the offence.
