

THE ACTOR, EVENT MODERATOR, AND JUDGE MUST READ THROUGH THIS ENTIRE DOCUMENT PRIOR TO THE START OF COMPETITION.

This document includes detailed call information and partial scripts for the actor to use. The actor should practice this scenario with the judge and event moderator multiple times so that they are comfortable with the information.

YOU MUST PROVIDE EACH COMPETITOR THE SAME SCENARIO WITH THE SAME VOICE INFLECTIONS. WHAT YOU DO FOR ONE YOU MUST DO FOR EVERYONE.

Actor: Dials the pretend 911 number.

Competitor: Answers the phone using appropriate greeting.

Actor: (using a quiet, panicked/ nervous voice)

SAY EXACTLY: "Hurry, send someone to my house. I think someone is in my living room"

Competitor will begin asking questions regarding the call and filling in the call sheet. Provide the information from the table below to the competitor only if asked. **DO NOT OFFER INFORMATION THAT WAS NOT ASKED FOR.**

If there is a break in questioning, the actor should make the following statement:

SAY EXACTLY: " I am going to get the gun out of my parents nightstand and see if I can find out who is in my house"

The competitor should advise against this behavior.

Do not press the issue to far. You may make a similar statement again if the competitor does not respond to your statement. You may also use the following statements as a rebuttal to their advisory against getting the gun.

Actor: (agitated, louder voice)

" I am home alone, I need to protect myself"

" I am not going to just stand by and and let someone steal all of my stuff"

" Well you haven't sent anyone yet, I need to help myself"

Do not drag this out for very long. The competition is timed and you do not want this to take up too much time.

*Avoid deviating from the script/ information as much as possible. If the competitor asks for information that you do not have, advise that the information is unavailable. *

Question	Answer	Tone of Voice/ Special Instructions
Reporting Party Name	Tab Jenkins (regardless of actors gender) 13 years old	Provide only the first name unless asked for full name. Provide last name if asked.
Incident Address Description	Two story beige house, brick mailbox, lots of pink flowers in flower bed.	Provide information when prompted by competitor.
Reporting Party Phone Number	(806)125-8452	Provide information when prompted by competitor.
Incident Address	73425 Michigan Avenue Bryan, TX 77424	Only provide if they ask specifically where the incident is.
Incident Location Homeowner Status	Parents are out on a date at the movie theater	Provide information when prompted by competitor.
Activity being reported	Caller is home alone. She was in her parents room looking for her missing shoe when she heard a glass breaking sound in her living room. She quietly closed her parents bedroom door and is hiding in the bathroom closet.	Provide information when prompted by competitor.
Suspect Description	Unknown	Provide information when prompted by competitor.
Suspect Vehicle Description	Unknown	Provide information when prompted by competitor.
Suspect Weapon Information	Unknown	Provide information when prompted by competitor.

You may choose to escalate the call if the competitor is slow to ask the appropriate questions. For example, if there is a lot of dead air, you may have the actor state that they hear the person moving closer to the bedroom,

shaking the door knob, entering the bedroom, and so on. Do not go to far in to this and do not allow the suspect to find the victim.
