God wants us well.

There is no doubt or uncertainty in the word of God; that God wants His people well spirit, soul and body. There are hundreds of promises in the Bible; that testify of God's willingness and ability to heal us and keep us in divine health. The Bible says in third John chapter one:

Beloved, I wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers. (3John 1:2)

The word of God can give us health from the inside out. If God sent His son Jesus to save us from all our sin and redeem us from the curse, then it would not be a finished work if He did not

provide for our physical health. But praise the Lord He did. He has not only taken and payed for our sins, but he has also taken and paid for our sickness.

Old Testament laws and consequences.

In the Old Testament (O.T) God had to put the law and the 10 commandments in place; so that man could recognise and acknowledge his sin. Because without the law in place (telling people what was right and wrong), mankind did not know what sin was.

What then shall we say? That the law is sin? By no means! Yet if it had not been for the law, I would not have known sin. For I would not have known what it is to

covet if the law had not said, "You shall not covet." (Romans 7:7)

The law was put into place; to protect and guide people away from sin and its devastating consequences. But if someone still chose to disobey God, he would not override their wills. God has given every person a will and choice of their own. If we can understand this characteristic of God; we will also understand many other things about him. The world is in the state it is today; because God is not in charge. If he was in charge here on earth then it would be just like Heaven, where there is no sickness, pain or dis-ease. He has given man authority and dominion of his affairs here on earth.

*Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. (Genesis 1:26-27)*

*I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and **whatever you** bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Matthew 16:19)*

He has certainly not left us powerless and alone. He has given us his word, his Holy Spirit and his authority through

the name of Jesus. We can whip any devil, move any mountain or defeat any sickness or dis-ease that comes across our path, with the mighty weapons God has given us.

*For though we walk in the flesh, we are not waging war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, **but have divine power to destroy strongholds.***

(2 Corinthians 10:3-4)

All through the Old Testament God was always willing and able to heal his people, and to keep them in excellent health. But if someone broke the law or disobeyed God, they would unfortunately bring the consequences of the curse onto themselves. God does

not make people sick, or work any evil to anyone. If he did then that would make him a devil or evil, and he would have no right to judge or hold man accountable for working evil. He would also have no power over evil; because he would be working alongside it in partnership. No! God does not work evil, but he will allow evil to happen in peoples lives, because he has given each man his own will and choice. God will allow you to go down to the local supermarket and rob it if you want to.

In the book of 1st Chronicles chapter 13; you can read a testimony of King David trying to bring back the ark of God to his home town. There was a statement made in verse 10 that says: "And the anger of the LORD was kindled against

Uzzah, and he struck him down". God had already given Israel instructions about how to transport and handle the ark. He told them that only the Priests of the tribe of Levite could handle and touch the ark. But one day while the ark was being transported incorrectly, a man named Uzzah reached out to stop the ark from falling off the cart, and he fell stone dead. God never struck him dead, God already gave the Israelites instructions to keep them from trouble, but David disobeyed them and Uzzah died because of it.

"If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases

*on you that I put on the Egyptians, **for I am the LORD, your healer.**"*

(Exodus 15:16)

A few passages of the O.T scriptures in the Bible have been wrongly translated into the King James. If you read the Bible you will know for yourself that God doesn't make people sick, if he did then Jesus would have certainly made some folks sick, or even refused to heal some of them. This passage of scripture was supposed to be translated "*I will allow none of the diseases on you that I allowed on the Egyptians, **for I am the LORD, your healer.**"* God already told us in this passage of scripture what he is, he is not confused or double minded; "He is the LORD our healer."

In the O.T people had the benefits of living their full length of life in good health, not having to die from sickness or dis-ease. We have an even better covenant based on even better promises, (Hebrews 8) since Jesus came to die on the cross. But it is up to each individual if we are going to believe it or reject it.

*Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, **who heals all your diseases.***
(Psalm 103:2-3)

In 2nd Kings chapter 20 the Bible tells us about King Hezekiah, who became terminally ill because of disobedience and pride that had crept into his life. He became very rich and blessed by God,

but through a silly act of pride and disobedience; he literally stripped the treasures out of the Temple of God, to give them to the king of Assyria as a gift.

*In those days Hezekiah became **sick and was at the point of death**. And Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz came to him and said to him, "Thus says the LORD, 'Set your house in order, for you shall die; you shall not recover.'" **Then Hezekiah turned his face to the wall and prayed to the LORD, saying, "Now, O LORD, please remember how I have walked before you in faithfulness and with a whole heart, and have done what is good in your sight."** And Hezekiah wept bitterly. And **before Isaiah had gone out of the middle court, the word of the***

LORD came to him: "Turn back, and say to Hezekiah the leader of my people, Thus says the LORD, the God of David your father: I have heard your prayer; I have seen your tears. Behold, I will heal you. On the third day you shall go up to the house of the LORD, and I will add fifteen years to your life. I will deliver you and this city out of the hand of the king of Assyria, and I will defend this city for my own sake and for my servant David's sake." (2Kings 20:1-6)

As soon as Hezekiah realised what he had done, and turned to God in repentance; God healed him and added 15 years to his life. God is, and always has been greatly desiring to heal his people and keep us in good health. Before Isaiah the Prophet even left the

building, God sent him back to Hezekiah to inform him that he would restore his health.

The Old Testament (O.T) is filled with wonderful promises of healing, health and long life. Today if you are believing God for healing; you can take some of the scriptures and see for yourself what God's word says about your situation.

Here are a couple of verses and a faith confession you can read over your life, or the life of a loved one you may be believing for:

For I will restore health to you, and I will heal you of your wounds, says the LORD. (Jeremiah 30:17)

Behold, I will bring it/you health and healing, and I will heal them/you, and will reveal unto

*them\you the abundance of peace and truth.
(Jeremiah 33:6)*

*Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not
dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen
thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee
with the right hand of my righteousness. (Isaiah
41:10)*

*"If you will diligently listen to the voice of the
LORD your God, and do that which is right in his
eyes, and give ear to his commandments and
keep all his statutes, I will allow none of the
diseases on you that I allowed on the Egyptians,
for I am the LORD, your healer."
(Exodus 15:26)*

*Then shall thy light break forth as the morning,
and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and
thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory
of the LORD shall be thy rear guard.
(Isaiah 58:8)*

The LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will allow none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee. (Deuteronomy 7:15)

So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare children. (Genesis 20:17)

The LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people. (2Chronicles 30:20)

"O LORD, God of Israel, there is no God like you, in heaven or on earth, keeping covenant and showing steadfast love to your servants who walk before you with all their heart. (2Chronicles 6:14)

The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. The LORD is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. (Psalm 145:8-9)

Touching the Almighty, we cannot find him out: he is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict. (Job 37:23)

*That thy way may be known upon earth, thy
saving health among all nations. (Psalm
67:2)*

*He brought them forth also with silver and gold:
and there was not one feeble person among their
tribes. (Psalm 105:37)*

*Who forgives all thine iniquities; who heals all thy
diseases; Who redeems thy life from destruction;
who crowns thee with lovingkindness and tender
mercies. (Psalm 103:3-4)*

*He heals the broken in heart, and binds up their
wounds. (Psalm 147:3)*

*The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
(Psalm 23:1)*

*O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast
healed me. (Psalm 30:2)*

*Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art
thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I*

shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God. (Psalm 42:11)

The LORD sustains him on his sickbed; in his illness you restore him to full health. (Psalm 41:3)

Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his stripes we are healed.

(Isaiah 53:4-5)

Make this Faith Confession over you or your loved ones:

“Thank you Lord that according to what your word says: you want me to be well. I believe that no matter what I am going through, I can receive my healing,

because you love me and your gift of healing to me is free if I will receive it. Jesus payed for my sickness and disease and I believe it. In the name of Jesus Christ, I speak to my body and say that I am healed. I will not believe the bad report or negative words, that me or anyone else has been speaking over my life. I am speaking God's divine health into my body, and I receive it right now in Jesus name."

You may find that as you continue reading this book, God is going to give you even more understanding about healing, and you may want to come back and make this faith confession again, but with even more faith than before.

Jesus is the expressed character of God on Healing.

When Jesus was on the earth in a bodily form; he represented everything that the Father is, and did everything the Father told him to do. Jesus was the express image and exact will of God for all humanity.

*Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me **does his works**. (John 14:10)*

He (Jesus) is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power...(Hebrews 1:3)

Nowhere in the Bible will you ever find Jesus turn anyone away who wanted healing, no matter how good or bad they were, because our healing is not dependant on who we are, but on our faith. The only time he ever corrected or rebuked someone was because of their unbelief. Without believing that God wants to heal us, we cannot receive anything. Unbelief is worse then sickness, because sickness can still be healed if we have faith, but unbelief can send us to an early grave. In Matthew chapter 8 the Bible testifies of a man who came to Jesus for healing, he was a leper:

*Behold, a leper came to him (Jesus) and knelt before him, saying, "Lord, **if you will**, you can make me clean." And Jesus*

stretched out his hand and touched him, saying, "I will; be clean." And immediately his leprosy was cleansed. (Matthew 8:2-3)

Notice what Jesus said to the man's statement "*if you will?*" the man said. Jesus answered him and said "***I will; be clean.***" Jesus was answering humanities question about God's willingness to heal us. He took the opportunity to show us that God is willing to heal us, and said to the man "*I will.*" In almost every single case of healing in the Bible, Jesus (God) never asked anyone: "where do you go to church?" or "what denomination do you belong to?" or "have you been a good person?" He just healed them and then said to some of them "go and sin no more." Sin doesn't have to stop you

from receiving your healing, because healing is received by faith not by works. If we can receive salvation by faith when we are a sinner, then we can also receive healing by faith when we are a sinner. Sin can certainly bring sickness into our lives, but if we will simply repent from it and ask God for forgiveness, he is faithful and just to forgive us and cleanse us from all of our unrighteousness.

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

In the book of John chapter 5; Jesus walked into a place called the pool of Bethesda one day, and there was a man lying there who had been a cripple for 38

years. Jesus asked him if he wanted to be well, but the man didn't understand him and replied "I have no one to carry me to the pool." Jesus said to the man "take up your bed and walk." Then later on when he met the man in the Temple, he said to him *"See, you are well! Sin no more, that nothing worse may happen to you."* He healed the man first then told him to sin no more. Healing is an expression of God's love for all of us. The bible says in Romans 5 and 1John 4:

God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

We love because he first loved us. (1John 4:19)

The love of God for every human being is the same, no matter if we acknowledge and believe him, or if we reject him and disbelieve him. If we will do the smart thing and acknowledge and believe him, we will receive what he has promised us. Here are a few passages of scripture that really make religious people mad, because they cannot explain, why everyone, in this passage and many others like it got healed.

*Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. And many followed him, **and he healed them all.** (Matthew 12:15)*

He (Jesus) came down with them and stood on a level place, with a great crowd of his disciples and a great multitude of

*people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, Who came to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. And those who were troubled with unclean spirits were cured. And **all the crowd sought to touch him, for power came out from him and healed them all.** (Luke 6:17-19)*

The Disciples also had the same experience when they went out to heal the sick.

*The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and they **were all healed.** (Act 5:16)*

There must have been someone in those crowds of people who went to

Jesus for healing, who were not perfect sinless or even a Christian. But every one of them who came and believed that Jesus would heal them; got their healing. In fact the passage in Luke 6 says that "***all the crowd sought to touch him, for power came out from him and healed them all.***" It seems that Jesus did not always determine who was getting healed, the people did. The ones who reached out by faith and took their healing got healed, and the ones who decided that they didn't believe this stuff, would have gotten nothing. But on this particular day everyone seemed to reach out and get their healing, and no one was refused by Jesus. This is the good news of the Gospel that Christ came to bring us.

In Luke 4 he opened a scroll and read out loud for all of humanity to hear:

*"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."
(Luke 4:18-19)*

In Acts 10 verse 38 the Apostle Peter is preaching at the home of Cornelius, and he testifies to them of what he has heard and seen about Jesus:

*How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good **and healing all***

*who were oppressed by the devil, **for God was with him.** (Act 10:38)*

God was with him. God was the one doing the work through him all the time. Isn't that wonderful news that God wants us well.

**Healing is for today and for you
right now.**

Some religious or wrongly informed people may try and convince you that healing is not for today, that only the Apostles could heal the sick, or that God doesn't really do it anymore, he only uses Medical Doctors now. That is a lie the devil has been trying to put over on people for thousands of years. If it weren't for medical Doctors many

people would already be dead today, thank goodness for Doctors. But God wants to be the source of our healing, and the one who keeps us in good health and gives us long life. It doesn't take years of experience and bags full of money or the right circumstances, to receive what he has promised us. Faith is ready to believe and receive any time it needs to. The Bible says in Numbers 23 and Hebrews 13:

God is not a man, that he should lie, or a son of a man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it? (Numbers 23:19)

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. (Hebrews 13:8)

That settles it, if God was willing and able to do it in the Bible, He will still do it today for you. We can heal the sick and receive our healing today, just like the believer's in the Bible did. No matter what the Doctor's feedback is, how long you have been suffering, or even how negative your report is; you can receive your healing.

God's prescription.

There are a few things that we will have to do, if we are going to see a Doctor and endeavour to get better. The first is that we are going to have to honour and respect the Doctors Knowledge, experience and advice he or she gives. If we go to the Doctor and sit in front of him, and try and advise him about what

we think he should be doing, or argue and debate over every bit of advice he gives us, we are probably wasting our time and his. In the same way we will have to be willing to honour God and his word and give it first place in our situation. He has the answers and solutions for us to receive our healing, but without us believing and trusting that what he says is the truth, we are wasting our time and efforts. Another thing that we will have to do if we go and visit a Doctor; is to take his prescription and go and do what he has told us to do, and take what he has told us to take. If we go to the Doctors office and trust his advice, and believe that what he says will help us, but then walk out of the office and don't do what he has prescribed for us to do, we will not

gain anything useful from the visit, except some knowledge. In the same way we will have to do what God's word tells us to do, and keep on doing it until it begins to have the affect He said it will have. We can't quit after the first day or week. If the Doctor prescribed a 6 or 12 month course of pills or medicine, we would have to obey him, even if we didn't feel any different, because we trust his ability and knowledge to get us better. In the same way we will have to honour and trust that what ever God is instructing us to do, is going to have it's desired effect on our lives or bodies.

God has given us a simple and clear prescription of how to get our healing, and stay healthy. Here are some of His

prescriptions and instructions if we want to be well:

*My son/daughter, **be attentive** to my words; **incline your ear** to my sayings. **Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart.** For they **are life** to those who find them, **and healing/medicine to all their flesh.** Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it **flow the springs of life.** **Put away from you crooked speech, and put devious talk far from you.** (Prov 4:20-24)*

God says in Proverbs chapter 3 that we must keep his word as our number one focus, we must give it our full attention everyday (depending on how quick you want to be well). We must not be listening to everyone else, or looking at

everything else that comes across our path, social media or television. The word of God is healing or another translation says "medicine" to all our flesh. The more of the medicine of the word of God we take daily, by reading it, believing it, and confessing it, the quicker we are going to get results. Proverbs 3 also says that we must "keep our heart with all diligence." In other words; don't let people or bad reports and symptoms speak you out of what you are believing from the word of God. The Bible says in Mark chapter 4 verse 15 when Jesus is teaching us how to receive the word. That the enemy satan comes immediately to try and steal the word from you heart. He will use whatever we will respond to, negative talk, bad reports, circumstances or even

just forgetting or neglecting to take your daily dose of medicine. Another principle and instruction God gives us: is to watch what we say about our situation. Don't let your words go crooked from the word that you are standing on, don't let your mouth just say whatever it feels like, if it is not in line with what you are believing for. Our words carry the power of life and death over our situation.

For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." (Matthew 12:37)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits. (Proverbs 18:21)

Jesus answered them, "Have faith in God. Truly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says will come to pass, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours." (Mark 11:22-24)

The Bible says that out of the overflow or abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks (Luke 6:45). You can find out what is in your heart in abundance by listening to what is coming out of your mouth. If you are talking sickness, doubt, unbelief or anything else negative, then your heart needs a good cleaning with the word. You need to fill your heart with the word and promises

God has given you about your situation, and keep on meditating on them and saying them. Let's go back to Mark chapter 11 and read further:

.....And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses." (Mark 11:25)

There is a conjunction in this sentence; "**and** whenever you stand praying forgive." Walking in love and forgiveness is part of receiving what you are believing for. Faith the Bible says works by love (Galatians 5:6). You can read the word, believe the word and speak the word all day long, but if you have something against someone, and

you won't forgive them, you are clogging up the delivery system. Faith works by love, it functions at it's full capacity, when we live in love. We all know that it isn't always easy to forgive and forget something that someone has done to us, or forget about something that someone said or did to us that hurt us, but if we are going to get our healing and stay healthy, we are going to have to do it for our own good. Just forget what people have said or done to you, or it will affect your receiving. Sometimes people don't even know that they offended or hurt us, but we are still hanging onto the offence. Someone may give you an offence, but it is up to you if you are going to take it. Jesus said that we should even forgive our enemies. If we will decide to forgive

someone just because we know it's the right thing to do, God will help and empower us to carry that decision out. He is our Father, he wants to help, strengthen and provide for us wherever we will allow him to.

Let's make another Faith Confession over you or your loved ones:

"Father I am going to take your prescription, and make your word my main focus. I am going to believe it and continue to speak it. I will not allow my mouth to say anything else different than to what I am believing in your word. I forgive anyone who has ever said or done anything against me or my loved ones, I let it go by faith, I will forgive them and forget it. Thank you

God that I am living in love, I am quick to forgive, quick to repent when I am wrong, and quick to believe. I receive my healing in Jesus name.”

New Testament promises and healing.

The New Testament (N.T) is filled with so many verses and examples on healing; that it would be very difficult to convince anyone that God does not want us well. But you may meet some wrongly informed or religious people that will try and build a doctrine, on 1 or 2 passages of scripture. We can never build a doctrine on 1 or 2 passages of scripture, when there are hundreds and even thousands of scriptures

throughout the Bible that promise us healing.

(Near the end of this book I will provide you with many healing scriptures that you can use to study, believe and speak out over your life or a loved one you are believing for.)

The devil and his demons were so afraid and accustomed to Jesus casting them out of people; that when he landed at a town called Gerasenes, a demon possessed man came running up to him and said "*What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I adjure you by God, do not torment me.*" (Mark 5) The devil knew that when Jesus and his followers came to town, any evil work that had been done in people's

lives would have to go, if they believed. Jesus said in Luke 4:18 that this is what he was anointed for, and in first John 3 we read:

*Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. **The reason the Son of God appeared** was to destroy the works of the devil. (1John 3:8)*

Jesus rose from the dead and he is still anointed today to do the same for anyone who will receive it.

Receiving our Healing.

The way that we can receive our healing is by taking the word of God literally. It is not a book full of old stories or tales. It

is a living testimony of what God came to do for humanity, and the many testimonies of others who had prophesied the coming of Jesus, experienced his love for themselves, and wrote about it for generations to read and believe. When Jesus was here on earth in a bodily form, he would heal people by touching them, speaking to them or they would even receive their healing from his presence. In Acts chapter 5 there is an account of one of Jesus disciples Peter, who carried the presence of God that even when his shadow passed by people they would receive their healing.

*They even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by **at least his***

shadow might fall on some of them.
*The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and **they were all healed.** (Act 5:15-16)*

Jesus still heals the same way today. When he left for Heaven he said in John 16 verse 7: "*Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper (Holy Spirit) will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.*" The Holy Spirit has been sent by God to do the same and even more works than Jesus did. Because the Holy Spirit can be everywhere at once healing, delivering and saving people all over the world. He is the one bringing healing to everyone everywhere. The Bible says in John 1

that Jesus was the word of God that became flesh, in other words; the word of God became a person called Jesus, and the word/Jesus brought healing to everyone who believed in him.

The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

Jesus is the word and the word is Jesus. We will receive our healing when we believe God's word about our circumstances, because the same power that was released through Jesus to heal the sick, will be released to us when we believe his word. God also uses people who are anointed by him and carriers of his healing power to heal

the sick. Every believer (who knows the word, and knows who they are in Christ) has the power of the Holy Spirit to heal the sick. We can receive our healing by believing the word, but also by having hands layed on us according to Mark 16.

*"These signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; **they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover.**" So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. And they went out and preached everywhere, **while the Lord***

worked with them and confirmed the message by accompanying signs. (Mark 16:17-20)

*Is anyone among you sick? **Let him call for the elders of the church**, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the **prayer of faith will save the one who is sick**, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.* (James 5:14-16)

Sometimes we may not feel strong enough physically or even strong enough in the word to believe God for

our healing. The Bible instructs us in James 5:14 that we can call for mature believers or Elders from our local church, which can lay hands on us and pray the "*prayer of faith*", and "*the Lord will raise him up.*" If you don't have the privilege of belonging to a word based local church like that, then you can also take the word of God; and pray the prayer of faith for yourself. Notice in verse 15 it says "*the prayer of faith.*" Anyone can pray the prayer of faith; it just depends on who you are putting your faith in. You can take the word of God and pray it over your life or someone else, and the Lord will honour it and "*raise him/them up.*" Mark 11 says that "*whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.*"

*Jesus answered them, "Have faith in God. Truly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says will come to pass, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, **whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.** (Mark 11:22-14)*

Another way that we can receive our healing is through the presence of God. God's presence is just as real today as it was in the Bible, because the Holy Spirit can come and manifest God's presence to us right in our room or prayer closet. The strongest and greatest manifestation of God's presence happens, when a body or congregation of believer's come together in a local

meeting like a church or evangelism event. Sometimes the presence of God begins to manifest and operate with such power that miracles begin to happen.

God has many ways to get his healing power through to you or your loved ones, the only avenue that is a must for everyone who will receive, is faith. Feed your faith on the word of God, it is the main source God uses to strengthen our faith. Romans 10:17 says that "*faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.*" The more we feed our faith on the word of God, the stronger it will become and the easier it will be for us to receive. We can't be lazy, forgetful or undisciplined if we want to get results. Anyone who wants

their healing has to be diligent and focused. If you have been on medication before or taken a prescription from a Doctor, you know what it means to be diligently focused on getting well. If we will exercise the same diligence and focus with God's word, that we are willing to exercise in many other areas of our lives; we are guaranteed to get what we are believing for, and even more.

Bible verses.

Below are some Bible verses that you can use to study, believe, pray and speak out over your life or the life of a loved one you are believing for:

Mat 7:11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

Isa 53:4 Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

Isa 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his stripes we are healed.

Mat 8:17 This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah: "Himself took our illnesses and bore our dis-eases."

1Pe 2:24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his stripes/bruises you have been healed.

Jas 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

1Thess 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Deu 5:33 Ye shall walk in all the ways which the LORD your God hath commanded you, that ye may live, and that it may be well with you, and that ye may prolong your days in the land which ye shall possess.

Deu 11:21 That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.

1Chron 29:28 And he (which was DAVID) died in a good old age, full of days, riches, and honour: and Solomon his son reigned in his stead.

Job 5:26 Thou shalt come to thy grave in a full age, like as a shock of corn cometh in in his season.

Psa 91:10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

Psa 91:11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

Psa 91:12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Psa 91:13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

Psa 91:14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

Psa 91:15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

Psa 91:16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Pro 3:1 My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

Pro 3:2 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

Isa 40:31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Eph 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

Eph 6:2 Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;)

Eph 6:3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

Mat 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Mat 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

Mat 9:20 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, and touched the hem of his garment:

Mat 9:21 For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

Mat 9:22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Mat 9:27 And as Jesus passed on from there, two blind men followed him, crying aloud, "Have mercy on us, Son of David."

Mat 9:28 When he entered the house, the blind men came to him, and Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to him, "Yes, Lord."

Mat 9:29 Then he touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith be it done to you."

Mat 9:30 And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them, "See that no one knows about it."

Mat 9:31 But they went away and spread his fame through all that district.

Mat 9:32 As they were going away, behold, a demon-oppressed man who was mute was brought to him.

Mat 9:33 And when the demon had been cast out, the mute man spoke. And the crowds marveled, saying, "Never was anything like this seen in Israel."

Mat 9:34 But the Pharisees said, "He casts out demons by the prince of demons."

Mat 9:35 And Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction among the people.

Mat 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Mat 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

Mat 11:30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Mat 12:15 But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from there: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;

Mat 14:13 When Jesus heard of it, he departed there by ship into a desert place apart: and when the people had heard thereof, they followed him on foot out of the cities.

Mat 14:14 And Jesus went, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.

Mat 14:34 And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret.

Mat 14:35 And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought to him all that were diseased;

Mat 14:36 And sought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.

Mat 15:29 And Jesus departed from there, and came to the sea of Galilee; and went up into a mountain, and sat down there.

Mat 15:30 And great multitudes came to him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and put them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them:

Mat 15:31 so that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

Joh 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Act 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

1Jn 3:8 He that commits sin is of the devil; for the devil sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy/loosen the works of the devil.

Mat 10:1 And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Mar 16:15 And he said to them, Go into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

Mar 16:16 He that believes and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believes not shall be damned.

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

SKIP DOWN TO VERSE 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Joh 14:12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.

Joh 14:13 Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Joh 14:14 If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

Joh 14:15 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

Act 8:6 And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake,

hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

Act 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Act 9:33 And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy.

Act 9:34 And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ makes you whole: get up, and make your bed. And he arose immediately.

Act 14:8 Now at Lystra there was a man sitting who could not use his feet. He was crippled from birth and had never walked.

Act 14:9 He listened to Paul speaking. And Paul, looking intently at him and perceived that he had faith to be made well,

Act 14:10 said in a loud voice, "Stand upright on your feet." And he sprang up and began walking.

Act 19:11 And God was doing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul,

Act 19:12 so that even handkerchiefs or aprons that had touched his skin were carried away to the sick, and their diseases left them and the evil spirits came out of them.

Jas 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Jas 5:15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Jas 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

Mal 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Joh 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

Joh 16:24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

Mar 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

Mar 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Joh 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Joh 14:14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

Mat 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.

Rom 4:17 (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickens the dead, and calls those things which be not as though they were.

Rom 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

Rom 4:19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an 100 years old, neither the deadness of Sara's womb:

Rom 4:20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

Rom 4:21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

Rom 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1Ti 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Heb 11:2 For by it the elders obtained a good report.

Heb 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Heb 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

1Jn 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

1Jn 5:5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

1Jn 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

Phil 2:13 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

2Ti 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Psa 107:20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Isa 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

Heb 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession or confession.

Heb 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Heb 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession or confession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

Heb 10:35 Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.

Heb 10:36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

Rev 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony.
