Building a Storehouse Together

God shaped the world through a wisdom that gave him immense delight in seeing his own glorious nature reflected in creation (Prov 8:30-31). Therefore, Adam and Eve were supremely gifted with skills and abilities to bring the unfinished creation to completion (Gen 1:28; 2:15). They unwisely chose something below them (Rom 3:23). Though the self-centered corrupted gifts of humanity, such as building the tower of Babel (Gen 11:1-9), still revealed something of divine creative power (Rom 11:29). When God later blessed Israel with covenant, he called and gifted Spirit-endowed men and women to make things for his own praise honour and glory. The design, craftsmanship and artistry behind the tabernacle and the Temple (Ex 31:2-5; 1 Ki 7:13-14) are outstanding Old Testament examples.

The giftedness which pleases the Lord is not simply a matter of outstanding ability, as the examples of evil genius of the devil reveals. God himself must get the glory. Two dispositions turn gifts from God into operations that build his kingdom. The first is divine wisdom (Prov 24:3), the other is sacrificial love. These are embodied in the death of Christ. The cross is both the wisdom and power of God offered up in sacrificial love through which God creates a whole new universe (1 Cor 1:24). This wisdom in Christ is so diversely splendid that Paul uses a word connected to Joseph's "coat of many colours" (Gen 37:3) to describe it as "the wisdom of God in its rich variety" (Eph 3:10). Excitingly, this creative wisdom resides in the church.

St Marks has many people with special gifts which can be displayed beyond a Sunday: painting, poetry, carpentry, metal work, engineering, craft, counselling, hospitality, and many others. We can keep these gifts to ourselves, or, through Christ's life (2 Cor 9:15) offer them sacrificially in the service of others apart from personal gain (Phil 2:3,5). "The Storehouse" is a vision of St Marks as a hub/platform, using the hall(?), where these gifts can be offered through mentoring and encouragement for the good of those in the community who want to develop their own abilities. The genius of the way of the cross teaches that it through many failures maturity comes, therefore a "Storehouse" built on this foundation (1 Cor 3:11) will be grace-filled, free of judgement and a place where folk can sense the real Jesus (John 1:16-17). What have you to give?
