No Mixed Blessing

In the Lord there is no “mixed blessing” By faith, Joseph understood this prophetically, “you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good” (Gen 50:20). For us, this perspective is only possible in Christ.

When the High Priest interrogated Jesus, ““Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?””, he ceased to stand silent but confidently declared, ““I am, and you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven.”” (Mark 14:61-62). The Lord was testifying to be the descendant of Abraham through whom God would bless the whole world. Just as God promised, “Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?” (Gen 18:18). To prove that Jesus was NOT the supreme messianic channel of blessing the Jewish leaders ordained the cross. they were sure a crucified man was a cursed man (Deut 21:23).

They could not see that if blessedness is having God as Father, Jesus was blessed even amidst the agony of the cross (Luke 23:34). Whilst at face value the shame and agony of crucifixion shouts “No!” at Jesus, the resurrection proclaims speaks an eternal “Yes!” (Rom 1:4; 6:4). God had to speak a “No” not to our sin carried by Christ on the cross, but affirmed Jesus personally in resurrection. This is the source of our blessedness.

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, 4 even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world” (Eph 1:3-4). In every circumstance of life every Christian, however we are feeling, shares in the essential blessedness of the Lord himself (Col 2:9-10).

““Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. 12 Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.” (Matt 5:11-12). What the world takes as a curse, in Christ we know is a blessing (Heb 11:26; 1 Pet 4:14), that will never end. “Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.” (Matt 25:34). In Christ, we live in pure blessedness.
