Sonship Forever

Hebrews lists a number of attributes that make Jesus superior to angels, he is worshipped by them and possesses a throne “forever and ever” (Heb 1:5-8). These are all properties of his Sonship as God. Jesus is the eternal Son just as much as God is the eternal Father. Those who worship Jesus (Matt 28:9, 17) honour God as God (Phil 2:10-11), and those who do not worship him reveal themselves as unsaved. They lack the Spirit of God and cannot submit to Jesus as Lord and Saviour. This seems simple enough, but what about of texts like the following:

“If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is *greater than I.*” (John 14:28). The Early Church said that Christ is, “Equal to the Father, as touching his Godhead; and inferior to the Father as touching his Manhood.” (Athanasian Creed). In terms of his divine nature Jesus in one with the Father, in terms of his human nature he was just like us. weak and mortal (Heb 4:15). What about the next text, “I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.” (John 20:17). The resurrected Jesus is about to return to the glory he shared with the Father in eternity (John 17:5), this is great news for us because it means in heaven he will not be limited in presence, knowledge, and power. He can no longer suffer, be tempted, or die. This is your future, “Beloved, we are God’s children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.” (1 John 3:2). When Christ Returns in glory our feeble human natures will be swallowed up into the limitless glory of his all-victorious humanity (1 Cor 15:54; 2 Cor 5:4). We will by grace become just like Jesus is now at the right hand of power (Mark 14:62). As such we will reign with Christ “forever and ever” (Rev 22:5) because all he is we will be. This is the powerful future hope that enables us to persist by faith in a world where everything is perishing. Before heaven we remain weak creatures through whom God’s power can be shown to other weak creatures that they too might be saved.

Excerpts from a book - NEVER TOO FAR - NEVER TOO FEW (100 YEARS OF BCA) By Robyn Powell.

A handful of people met together on 26th May 1919 to talk about how to get the good news of Jesus Christ into the outback. Revd. S. J. Kirkby became the first Organising Missioner of BCA in 1913. His first aim was to appoint a missioner to Wilcannia (NSW). The Revd. Fred Harvey was chosen ... and the Revd. Reg Hawkins moved into the Cobar parish. From none to two is a pretty good start!

S. J. Kirby set out to do exactly what he expected a missioner would do ... visit the tiny encampments at Cann River (Victoria), the fledgling towns, the lonely individuals in their tents. When he could get a small group together, he ran a church service and was encouraged by the number of people who came. It was not long before people began to see the possibilities in this wild area of the country and both male and female missioners set off to bring the gospel to the timber workers of Gippsland (Victoria).

Thanks to S.J. Kirby and enthusiastic missioners who have served in BCA throughout its 102 years of existence, it is still supporting ministries in remote communities across Australia.
