Budget Guidelines

It's important that we can assess general budget guidelines in order to provide an estimate that is realistic for the budget that the homeowner is working with. Here are some budget guidelines for remodeling projects we have done in the past,

Kitchen Remodels: \$35,000-\$100,000 (*Typical \$50-\$70k*)
Bathroom Remodels: \$20,000-\$60,000 (*Typical \$25-\$35k*)
Dormers/Additions: \$75,000-\$200,000 (*Typical \$85-\$150k*)

What To Expect

Once you contact us to get a quote Andres will contact you and set up a free in home design consultation to go over budget, design ideas and start formulating a design so we can create a generalized quote. Design Phase

The next step is to sign a design contract (typically 5% of total cost of the project) to move into the design phase of the project which includes;

- 1. Measure existing space for accurate dimensions to formulate a set of plans
- 2. Create concept design with client
- 3. Review design options with client to dial in the final design options
- 4. Finalize proposed design with client
- 5. Prepare a set of construction plans based on finalized design
- 6. Final review of construction plans, final estimate based on proposed design, , schedules and preparation of construction phase & sign contract for construction work to begin

Remodel Phase

Once the design phase is completed we can schedule your remodel to get started!
