[What Are Cookies?](#)

As almost all professional websites, our websites and online services may use cookies. Cookies are small data files, which enable visited websites to remember operations and settings performed by individual users and therefore it is not necessary to enter the data repeatedly. Cookies are saved on your computer through the web browser. They are used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future. Below we describe what information is gathered, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. You can also find out how you can prevent these cookies from being stored.

We use cookies for several reasons detailed below. Unfortunately, there is nowadays no option for disabling cookies without distorting the functionality and features they add to our websites.

[How To Disable Cookies?](#)

You can prevent the use of cookies by adjusting the settings of your web browser. Since each browser is a little bit different, look at your browser's Help Menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies. Please be aware that disabling cookies will affect or disable the functionality of our websites in the areas which need cookies for their proper function. Therefore, it is not recommended to disable cookies.

[What Cookies Do We Use?](#)

Cookies allow our websites to remember choices you make while browsing. We may also remember preferences such as text size, fonts, and other customizable site elements.

Our websites offer services to registered users and the cookies are used to remember that you are logged in when you refresh the websites. They may also be used to decide whether show some notifications which are targeted only on not subscribed users. When you submit data through a form, cookies may also be used to remember your user details to simplify your future use of the forms.

The information these cookies collect will not personally identify you, and they cannot track your browsing activity on non-Byzance websites.

[Do We Use The Third Party Cookies?](#)

On our websites, we use social media buttons or plugins that allow you to connect with your social network in various ways. For these elements to work, the social media websites (including Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn, Skype) will use cookies through our websites which may be used to enhance your profile on their site or contribute to the data they hold for various purposes outlined in their respective privacy policies.
