

Privacy Policy

This document provides an overview of the main principles of collecting and protecting personal and other data (“Privacy Policy”) by us, Byzance IT Solutions s.r.o., a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the Czech Republic, with its registered office at Růžová 1416/17, Nové Město, Postal Code 110 00 Prague 1, Czech Republic, ID No.: 05926050, registered in the Commercial Register administered by the Municipal Court in Prague, Section C, File 273126 (“we” or “us”).

This Privacy Policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their personal data is being used when accessing this web site or using Portal or Mobile app (together “Service”) by us. Please read our Privacy Policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your personal data.

By submitting the registration form in Portal or Mobile app, you grants to us, in accordance with Act no. 101/2000 Coll., about personal data protection and on the amendment of several other acts, as amended (“Act“), your consent with the processing of personal data provided in compliance with the Terms of Use and this Privacy Policy, for the Purposes (as defined below). We are obliged to protect all and any your data acquired during registration, in compliance with the Act. However, we may be legally required to provide the data we collect and process to (i) state administrative authorities, (ii) courts, (iii) law enforcement authorities, etc. in cases of compelled disclosure. The provision of data is voluntary. The consent is given for the duration of your registration in the Service.

[What personal information do we collect from you?](#)

When ordering or registering on our web site or mobile application, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your name, email address or other details to help you with your experience.

In the case of your registration (creating your user account) to Portal or Mobile app, we record your name or nickname (username) as a user, e-mail, phone number, password in an encrypted form and a personal picture of you.

When you are using Mobile app and you are in the monitored building, we record your actual indoor location.

Your additional data is obtained by cookies on our web site, as shown below.

For what purpose do we collect the provided data?

The provided personal data are collected in particular for the purpose of:

1. Identification of the user of Portal or Mobile app while registering or using the Service;
2. Provision of all functionalities of Service, in particular, but not limited to, of:
 1. Navigation in the monitored building;
 2. Search of other individuals (e.g. co-workers) in the monitored building;
 3. Reporting damaged equipment or facilities in the monitored building; and
 4. Provision of other localization based functionalities;
3. In addition, we may use your personal data in order to:
 1. Help us provide you with the communication and the Service;
 2. Confirm or correct personal data;
 3. Help us run our business and compliance programmes;
 4. Audit our business.

1. Purposes

Anonymized personal data are further used for maintenance reports, space utilization suggestions, space usage analytics, and other types of reports related to the monitored buildings.

How do we protect your personal data?

Our data processing is fully consistent with the Act as we implement a variety of technical and organizational security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information. Your personal information is contained behind secured networks protected by up-to-date antivirus software with a password-protected access to the storage and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential.

What are cookies and what kind of cookies do we use?

Cookies are small data files, which enable visited websites to remember operations and settings performed by individual users therefore it is not necessary to enter the data repeatedly. Cookies are saved on the user's computer through the web browser. They are used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future.

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your browser settings. Since browser is a little different, look at your browser's Help Menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies.

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personal data. However, your name, phone number and localization data may be accessible in real time to other users of the Service with respect to the relevant building(s) monitored under one contract or related contracts concluded between us as a Service provider and our customer who ensures provision of the Service to you.

We process all personal data only in a scope necessary for the fulfilling of the Purposes and usually only for such time as shall be necessary for the fulfilling of the Purposes, and for no longer than the period of time set forth by applicable legal regulations.

2. Your rights
